PRESENTATION

The most important innovations introduced this year in the call all refer to the Decree of the Minister of University and Research of 17 December 2021, no. 1320, with which the increase in the value of the scholarships was arranged and the access requirements were redefined.

The D.M. it disposes, in fact, to achieve the objectives indicated in the National Recovery and Resilience Plan. In particular, the Recovery Plan developed by the Government provides for actions aimed at supporting and expanding opportunities for young people who intend to undertake a university course.

Below is a brief description of the changes made:

- ☞ the reserve also extended to people with disabilities recognized pursuant to article 3, paragraphs 1 and 3, of law no. 104 and / or with a disability equal to or greater than 66%;
- ☞ for those enrolled in three-year, master's and single-cycle degree courses, limited to housing services, the benefit has been extended for a further semester, therefore those enrolled in the first year beyond the course will be able to take advantage of the accommodation place free of charge for the whole year;
- ☞ autonomy requirements: adequate income capacity goes from € 6,500 to € 9,000 per year;
- ☞ the total amount of the scholarship is increased: for non-resident students and independent students by € 900.00; for commuter students of € 700.00; for on-site students € 500.00;
- ☞ for students with an ISEE indicator lower than or equal to half the maximum reference limit, the total amount of the scholarship due is increased by 15%;
- ☞ for students with an ISEE indicator higher than 2/3 and up to the maximum reference limit, the total amount of the scholarship is gradually reduced up to 50%;
- ☞ the total amount of the scholarship for disabled people has increased by 40%;
- ☞ for female students enrolled in study courses in S.T.E.M. (Science, technology, engineering and mathematics) the total amount of the scholarship due is increased by 20%;
- ☞ students enrolled in several courses at the same time are allowed to obtain and keep the scholarship. In this case, the total amount of the scholarship due is increased by 20%, if they are in possession and maintain the merit requirements provided for by the aforementioned decree for the entire duration of the courses.

PART ONE

Generalities of the competition

Art. 1

Reference legislation

The call for applications for the award of scholarships, other financial contributions and services for the right to study for the A.Y. 2022/2023 is drawn up taking into account the training offer A.Y. 2022/2023 of the university institutions related to ERSU Messina, referred to in tab. 1 in the appendix, and in accordance with the following legislation:

- Ministerial Decree n. 509/99 laying down provisions on the new teaching system of universities which provides for: three-year degree courses, master's degree, single-cycle master's degree, specialization and research doctorate and the introduction of university training credits;
- Law no. 508 of 21.12.1999, "Reform of music conservatories";
- D.P.C.M. April 9, 2001 laying down provisions for the uniformity of treatment on the right to university studies;
- L. R. n. 20 of 25.11.2002 on the right to university study in Sicily and subsequent amendments. and ii .;
- Law no. 170 of 8 October 2010, "New rules on specific learning disorders in schools";

Art. 2

Purpose

This notice sets out the rules for participation in the competition for the granting of benefits to be provided in the form of scholarships, services and financial contributions for the 2022/2023 academic year.

Scholarships are funded by the following funds:

- revenue from the regional tax for the right to education;
- share of the State Integrative Fund (FIS) for scholarships, made available by the M.U.R. ;
- the institution's own resources;
- additional resources, as part of the PNRR, by the EU - Next Generation EU Initiative, investment 1.7 "Scholarships for university access" of Mission 4 component 1;
- support of the PON "Research and Innovation" 2014-2020 - ESF REACT EU - TO 13 - Axis IV - Action IV.3 any other resources assigned to the Body.

ERSU reserves the right to provide the above benefits based on the funds allocated and available in cash.

The percentages of funding to be assigned to reserved grants and other financial contributions are shown in table 2 in the appendix.

1/3 of the sums, excluding reserves, will be set aside for the award of scholarships to students enrolled in the first year.

For students enrolled in years subsequent to the first, the remaining sum (2/3) will be proportionally distributed among all degree courses and, within these, for course years in relation to the number of scholarship applications received by the deadlines set by this announcement.

A scholarship will be guaranteed to all degree courses for each year of the course.

Art. 3

How to participate

To participate in the competitions, applicants for benefits must perform the following procedure:

1. **ACCESS** the internet application made available in the reserved area of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal, accessible from the link <https://studenti.ersumessina.it>, as indicated below:
 - a) adult students in possession of an identity document issued by the Italian authorities (eg identity card) and international students who declare their residence in Italy, access the reserved area with SPID or CIE;
 - b) international students in possession exclusively of an identity document issued by the authorities of their country and not resident in Italy, access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register at first access);
 - c) underage students access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register on first access);
2. **FILL** in the required fields of the form;
3. **CONFIRM** the data entered and wait for an SMS with an OTP code for their validation (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
4. **VALIDATE** the data entered in the benefit request by reporting the OTP code received via SMS in the appropriate field (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
5. **FINISH** the procedure.

The request for benefits, for competition purposes, must be regularized, therefore the applicants for benefits must upload, through a special online procedure available in the appropriate subsection called "File" created for this purpose on the homepage of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal, a copy of the identity document (limited to those who have not logged into the portal with SPID) and any additional documentation (single files in pdf format) for the regularization of the scholarship application and which will be considered valid for the access to all the benefits / services provided by the Entity.

Example:

- front / back copy of the identity document (only those who have not logged in with SPID or CIE);
- copy of the residence permit (for international students);
- copy of the documentation certifying the disability (for those requesting reserved benefits);
- copy of the separation / divorce sentence (for students with separated / divorced parents);
- copy of documentation certifying the income / assets situation for ISEE equalized (for students with a family unit abroad);
- other (specify).



The aforementioned documents, if already in the possession of the Institution as they were uploaded last year in the appropriate "File" section of the reserved area of the student portal and still valid, will be considered valid for the purposes of regularizing the A.Y. benefit request. 2022/2023.

It is recommended to keep the "dossier" always updated and, if the documents have expired, immediately upload the new documentation essential to regularize the request for A.Y. benefits. 2022/2023.

Those who access the student portal with SPID or CIE, if they are not obliged to submit additional documentation valid for competition purposes, will not have to regularize the benefit request. Having been identified with SPID or with CIE, in fact, they will not have the obligation to upload the identity document in the "File" of the reserved area of the student portal.

To regularize the request for benefits, applicants A.Y. 2022/2023 will have to perform the following procedure:

- a. **ACCESS** in the manner indicated in art. 3, to the internet application made available on the personal page of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal;
- b. **FILL IN** the form relating to the acquisition of data relating to the individual additional documentation (for example, for the identity document, it is necessary to indicate the date of issue, expiration date, municipality that issued the document, etc ...);
- c. **SCAN** each document into a pdf file with a maximum size of 2 MB, (eg front / back copy of the identity document, certification attesting to disability, etc ...);
- d. **UPLOAD** (upload) the aforementioned pdf file.

Repeat the procedure for each scanned document (pdf file).

At the end of the online procedure of / validation of the beneficiary request, the interested party can present the receipt of registration of the same directly from the reserved area of the online services portal of the Entity.



Applications submitted by means other than the on-line procedure specifically prepared and described above will be excluded from the competition.

Please indicate a valid mailbox.

If the participants in the competition intend to rectify the data of an application already submitted, they will have to cancel it and repeat the entire procedure (submit via internet and send the application) in the manner described above. The last application submitted will be the one considered valid for the purposes of the competition.

All subjects participating in the competition are required to promptly notify the Entity of any changes made after the date of submission of the application relating to their university career, family situation, change of domicile, residence or address, modification or termination of the lease, etc.

The scholarships are initially disbursed on the basis of what is self-certified (with the exception of health documents).

Art. 4

Any additional documentation

Beneficiary applicants are required to upload (upload), through a special online procedure available in the appropriate subsection called "File" for this purpose created on the homepage of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal, a copy of the identity document (only those who do not have accessed the portal with SPID or CIE) and any additional documentation (single files in pdf format) for the regularization of the scholarship application and which will be considered valid for access to all the benefits / services provided by 'Body.

Some categories of students, in order for the request for benefits to be considered valid for competition purposes, are required to upload the following additional documentation:

- **Students with disabilities** - Medical certification, issued by the competent public administration, certifying the level of disability of not less than 66% or the conditions of severe disability referred to in art. 3 paragraph 3 of the law 5 February 1992 n. 104 or the specific learning disorder referred to in Law 170/2010;
- **Non-EU international students** - Photocopy of a valid residence permit (or copy of the payment for its renewal) and any calculation of the equalized ISEEU / ISPEU;
- **International students from poor countries (DM n. 156/2021)** - Photocopy of the valid residence permit (or copy of the payment for its issue / renewal) and Certification of the Italian Representation in the country of origin, which certifies that the student does not belong to a family known to have a high income and a high social level;
- **Stateless** - Certificate issued by the Civil Court;
- **Political refugees entitled to international protection** - Certificate issued by the Commission of the Ministry of the Interior;
- **Foreign students children of Sicilian emigrants abroad** - Certificate of their own foreign residence and of the family of origin and possible calculation of the equalized ISEEU / ISPEU;
- **Orphans of victims of work** - Certificate issued by INAIL;
- **Orphans for mafia reasons** - Certificate issued by the competent Prefecture;
- **Victims of usury or children of victims of usury** - Documentation issued by the competent authorities;
- **Orphans or students without parental responsibility following a court order, guests or hosted by public or private reception facilities** - Documentation issued by the competent structure.



The documents produced by international students, issued by the competent authorities of the country and written in a foreign language, must be translated into Italian and legalized in accordance with the provisions of current legislation.

The aforementioned documents, if already in the possession of the Entity (or, if they were uploaded, last year, in the appropriate section "File" of the reserved area of the student portal) and are still valid, will be considered valid for the regularization of the request for benefits A.Y. 2022/2023.

It is recommended to keep the "dossier" always up-to-date and, if the documents have expired, immediately upload the new documentation essential to regularize the request for A.Y. benefits. 2022/2023.

Art. 5

Incompatibility

The scholarships provided by ERSU are incompatible with other scholarships that may be granted by other public or private bodies and with university collaborations (part-time or tutoring activities according to the announcement of the institutions concerned), announced for the year academic 2022/23, with the exception of grants for the encouragement of tutoring activities, as well as for the didactic-supplementary, preparatory and recovery activities, as per art. 3 paragraph 2 of the Ministerial Decree 1047/2017.

ERSU scholarship recipients, who wish to benefit from other scholarships or carry out the activities mentioned, will in any case be entitled to the balance between the amount of the ERSU scholarship and the amount of the other scholarship or the amount received university institution / institute for university collaborations. Therefore, they must submit an adjustment request indicating the amount of the scholarship provided by other public / private bodies or the amount received by the university / institute for the aforementioned university collaborations.

The housing service provided by the ERSU is incompatible with the same service possibly granted by other public bodies (eg. INPS) or private.

The recipients of housing services provided by other public or private bodies, may in any case acquire the status of "non-resident" but will not be entitled, if recipients of a scholarship, to any additional monetary share of the scholarship relating to the aforementioned service.

Art. 6

Recipients

All students in good standing with the payment of the regional tax for the right to study, who are enrolled or intend to enroll for the A.Y., can participate in the competition 2022/23 to the University Institutions operating in the area of competence of the ERSU of Messina (see table 1 in the appendix) for the following types:

- three-year degree courses, single-cycle master's degrees and two-year master's degrees, in possession of the economic and merit requirements specified in articles 8 and 9;
- PhD courses (activated by universities pursuant to art. 4 of Legislative Decree 03/07/1998 n. 210) provided they are unpaid;
- specialization courses (with the exception of those in the medical area referred to in Legislative Decree no. 368 of 17 August 1999) provided they are unpaid;
- Higher Musical Education courses, which can only be accessed through the possession of a high school diploma;
- first level master's degree for students with a three-year degree. In this case, the master is an alternative to the first year of the corresponding master's degree;
- single-cycle degree courses, for students with a three-year degree, provided that the two-year master's degree has been abolished for the course in question. In this case, students can benefit for two years, plus any additional semester out of the course, starting from the fourth year and will participate in the competition by selecting, in the online form, the item "continuation of the three-year degree";
- three-year degree courses, single-cycle master's degrees and two-year master's degrees,

in which students have passed the course or faculty with validation of exams by enrolling in a new course, even if it is not congruent with the year of first enrollment, provided that have not benefited from benefits for the same course year. In this case, the university career will be evaluated net of validations;

Students enrolled, in accordance with current legislation, are allowed to obtain and maintain the scholarship, increased by 20%, at the same time as multiple study courses, if they possess and maintain the merit requirements for the entire duration of the courses. The increase referred to in the first period is not due in the event that the student loses the requirements for the scholarship with reference to the course of study to which the student has related the aforementioned increase.



Students who have renounced their studies or who have forfeited their studies, can participate in the competition as long as they pay the fees to the university institution to which they were enrolled and return the sums relating to the benefits granted (scholarship, bed fee, meals) of the academic year in question.

Notwithstanding the provisions of the first paragraph of this article, the following may participate in the competition subject to:

- undergraduates and students enrolled with reserve who plan to graduate within the extraordinary session relating to the academic year 2021/22 (March-April 2023).

In this case, the following cases can be outlined:

- a. students who, having obtained their degree within the extraordinary session relating to the academic year 2021/22 (March-April 2023) and not intending to enroll for the academic year 2022/23, lose the right to the monetary share of the scholarship for the AA 2022/23, without prejudice to the possibility of maintaining the bed (with advance payment of the fee according to the bracket and in accordance with the provisions of article 38 below) and access to catering services, at a reduced rate based on economic conditions, up to the moment of the degree;
- b. students who, having not graduated by the extraordinary session for the academic year 2021/22 (March-April 2023), will have to enroll for the A.Y. 2022/23 in the first year out of the course. The same will be entitled to the assignment of benefits for one semester, including reserved scholarships. In this case, for the attribution of the course year, what is stated in the following art. 9 of the announcement.

- students not yet graduated from the three-year course and enrolled with reserve in the first two-year master's year:

In this case, the following cases can be outlined:

- c. students who, having not completed their three-year degree by the extraordinary session for the academic year 2021/22 (March-April 2023), will enroll in the first semester out of the course. The same will be entitled to the assignment of benefits for one semester, including reserved scholarships.
- d. students who, having achieved their three-year degree within the extraordinary session for the academic year 2021/22 (March-April 2023), will enroll for the A.Y. 2022/23 in the first year of a master's course. The same will be entitled to the assignment of benefits, including reserved scholarships.

Graduating students requesting benefits, who have obtained their degree within the extraordinary session relating to the A.Y. 2021/22 (March-April 2023) and who subsequently intend to continue their studies and enroll for the A.Y. 2022/23 in the first year of the two-year master's degree, will be able to rectify their request for benefits (limited to information relating to career, from 1st year

out of the three-year degree course to 1st year two-year master's degree) **by 17 April 2023** by communicating by email at borsedistudio@ersu.me.it registration for the academic year 2022/23 in the first two-year master's year. The same will be inserted at the bottom of the ranking of competence.

Students requesting benefits not yet graduated from the three-year degree and enrolled with reserve in the first year of the two-year master's degree, who have not graduated by the extraordinary session relating to the A.Y. 2021/22 (March-April 2023) and who, consequently, enroll in the first year beyond the course of the three-year degree, will be able to rectify their request for benefits (limited to information relating to the career, from first year of master's degree to first year out of three-year degree course) **by 17 April 2023** by sending an email to borsedistudio@ersu.me.it enrollment for the AY 2022/23 in the first semester beyond the three-year course. The same will be inserted at the bottom of the ranking of competence.

Students who simultaneously access the courses of the training courses provided for by Ministerial Decree 606/2017 (FIT), as long as they meet the income merit requirements set out in this announcement, the normal duration of the study course attended is increased by one semester at each end. relating to the current student position, also with reference to the use of the right to study services.

Art. 7

Duration of granting of benefits

The benefits will be granted, on condition that the economic and merit requisites envisaged are met, for the periods indicated below:

- For the three-year, two-year and single-cycle master's degree courses (including the three-year and two-year experimental courses of Higher Artistic Education and Higher Musical Education courses) the duration of granting the benefits is seven semesters for courses of three-year degree, five semesters for two-year master's degree courses and single-cycle master's degree courses:
 - nine semesters if the duration of the course is 4 years
 - eleven semesters if the duration of the course is 5 years
 - thirteen semesters if the duration of the course is 6 years.

With regard to the scholarship for the first semester of the first year out of the course, the student is entitled to the disbursement of the scholarship halved, compared to the standard amounts provided for by type and bracket, indicated in table 12 in the appendix. Limited to housing services, the benefit is extended for a further semester, therefore those enrolled in the first year beyond the course can take advantage of the accommodation place free of charge.

- For students with disabilities referred to in art. 3 paragraph 1 and 3 of Law 104/1992 and / or with a disability of not less than 66%, referred to in Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001 or with specific learning disabilities referred to in Law 170/2010 three-year degree, two-year master's degree and single-cycle master's degree courses (including the three-year and two-year experimental courses of Higher Artistic Education and the courses of Higher Musical Education), the duration of the granting of benefits is nine semesters for the three-year degree courses, seven semesters for the courses of two-year master's degree and for single-cycle master's degree courses of:
 - eleven semesters if the duration of the course is 4 years;
 - thirteen semesters if the duration of the course is 5 years;
 - fifteen semesters if the duration of the course is 6 years.

With regard to the scholarship for the first semester of the second year out of the course,

the student is entitled to the disbursement of the scholarship halved, compared to the standard amounts provided for by type and bracket, indicated in table 12 in the appendix. Limited to housing services, the benefit is extended for a further semester, therefore those enrolled in the first year beyond the course can take advantage of the accommodation place free of charge.

For PhD courses and specialization schools, the duration of the granting of benefits is that provided for by the educational system (the 1st out of course is not foreseen).

Art. 8

Economic and financial requirements

The student's economic and financial conditions are identified, respectively, on the basis of the **Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator** and the **Equivalent Financial Situation Indicator**, pursuant to the Regulation on the methods of determining the new ISEE pursuant to the Prime Minister's Decree of 5 December 2013, D . Lgs. 147/2017, **with specific reference to services for the right to university study.**

The maximum limits of ISEE and ISPE for access to benefits for the A.Y. 2022/2023 are respectively € 21.901,60 and € 52.902,43, as reported in tab. 6 in the appendix.



Students in possession of a valid **ISEE certificate, with no omissions / discrepancies, with specific reference to benefits for the right to university study can participate in the competition.**

Those who make use of the ISEE certification for the request for benefits with the annotation of the discrepancies, must submit suitable documentation, issued by the intermediary (Bank, Poste Italiane, other) who communicated the financial reports to the Revenue Agency, to prove the completeness and truthfulness of the data indicated in the declaration (see table 16 in the appendix).

Students for whom the ISEE and / or ISPE value exceeds the limits shown in table 6 in the appendix are excluded from the benefits provided for in this Call.



The Single Substitute Declaration (DSU), for the purposes of calculating the ISEE for benefits for the right to university study, can be submitted to INPS, exclusively electronically (by connecting to the website www.inps.it or through the computer stations self service present at the INPS offices), to the Municipalities, to the Fiscal Assistance Centers (CAF) or to the ERSU of Messina (Body that provides the subsidized social service) through the Tax Assistance Centers (CAF) adhering to the National Council and signatories of the Memorandum of Understanding with ANDISU - National Association of Bodies for the Right to Education, signed on 3 June 2015 (see table 14 list CAF in the appendix).

The ISEE certificate is issued free of charge for the student.

If the interested parties, despite having requested the ISEE certificate for services for the right to university study, are not yet in possession of it at the time of completing the application, five days before the deadline for participation in the competition, they can indicate in the online request for the details of the receipt (Sender Protocol / CAF Protocol), issued by the CAF, certifying the submission of the DSU, for the purpose of issuing the ISEE certificate.

The student is required to verify the truthfulness and correctness of the data entered in the DSU.

The DPCM n. 159/2013 provides for the possibility of presenting current ISEE if applicants for access to subsidized services intend to detect changes in family and economic conditions for the purpose of calculating the ISEE of their family unit. In this case, the new ISEE and ISPE values must be lower than the limits set by the announcement for participation in the competition.

For the purposes of the correct definition of the family unit, reference should be made to the provisions of current legislation (some indications are given in table 7 in the appendix).

The **international student** must upload the equalized ISEE in the "Dossier" section of the personal page of the ERSU student portal **by 2:00 pm on 30 September 2022**. The calculation of the equalized ISEE / ISPEU must be done by a CAF Tax Assistance Center (see Table 17 in the appendix to the announcement), with reference to the nation in which the income is produced and the assets of the family of origin are available. If required, the documentation issued by the competent authorities of the country of origin, translated into Italian and legalized, must be attached to the scholarship application. The international student is always obliged to declare to the CAF also any income and assets possessed in Italy by their family unit.

The same, if resident in Italy, without income and assets abroad, being equivalent to Italian students, must be in possession of the ISEE certificate for benefits for the right to university study.

If the interested party, despite having requested the calculation of the equalized ISEE, is not yet in possession of it at the time of completing the application, **five days before** the deadline for participation in the competition has expired, he **can indicate only the tax code in the online request of the declarant**. The same must in any case communicate to the Entity, no later than the deadline set out in the announcement (during the period of submission of the request for rectification / data integration) the ISEE / ISPEU equalized values, under penalty of exclusion from the competition.

ATTENTION:

International students must upload their own ISEE and the required documentation to the "Dossier" by 2:00 pm on 30 September 2022 (deadline for submitting the data correction / integration form). They will thus be positioned in the ranking according to the score due.

Otherwise, they will be able to upload the equalized ISEE and the documentation required by 31 December 2022 in the "Dossier". They will thus be positioned at the bottom of the relevant ranking.

Art. 9

Merit requirements

For the purposes of determining the year of the course they belong to and the required merit, the students participating in the competition will be evaluated starting from their first enrollment or re-enrollment. "Enrollment year" is the one in which enrollment in the degree course currently attended for the first time took place, wherever and whenever it took place or "re-enrollment" only if, in addition to renouncing studies, the student has also waived the credits acquired. Housing services are granted for a further semester, always starting from the year of first registration.

a. Enrolled in the first year of the three-year, master's, single-cycle and first-level master's degree courses

For students enrolled in the first year of the three-year degree, two-year master's degree, single cycle master's degree and first level master's degree courses, without prejudice to the possession of a high school qualification, the merit requirements will be assessed ex post, i.e. deed of disbursement of the balance of the scholarship, as described in art. 24 and summarized in table 4 in the appendix.

b. Enrolled in the first year of specialization and research doctorate courses

For students enrolled in the first year of specialization and research doctorate courses, the necessary merit requirement is that provided for by the respective didactic regulations. In this case, enrollment at the University of Messina for the A.Y. will be verified in progress.

c. Enrolled in years following the first

Students enrolled in years subsequent to the first, at the time of submitting the application, must be in possession of a minimum number of CFU (university formative credits). These credits must be **acquired by 10 August 2022**, in accordance with the provisions of art. 5 paragraph 2 of the M.U.R. of 3 November 1999 and summarized in tables 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4 in the appendix.



Students participating in the competition, in the online application, must declare that they meet the merit requirement, specifying the total number of credits **obtained and registered on the study plan as of August 10, 2022**. In case of non-registration of credits by of the secretariat, the student's position will be suspended pending its definition.

Consult the GUIDELINES for the correct determination of merit in the appendix to the announcement.

If it is not possible to acquire information relating to university careers and the merit achieved ex officio, ERSU reserves the right to ask the student for suitable documentation.

On the basis of official communications from the university institutions relating to the ERSU of Messina about the existence of study plans that provide for a distribution of credits other than that established by art. 5 paragraph 2 of the M.U.R. of 3 November 1999 (or 60 ECTS for each year of the course), to allow students to participate in the competition, ERSU re-evaluates the number of ECTS required, applying the same proportion according to art. 6 paragraph 4 of the D.P.C.M. of 9 April 2001 (see tables 5.1, 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4 in the appendix).

The minimum number of credits is rounded using the arithmetic criterion.



Credits validated for any reason cannot be considered, for the purposes of assessing merit, even in the event that the student has renounced or has forfeited his studies at any university or university degree institute;

For degree courses whose didactic organization includes modules or blocks, only credits from closed modules or blocks that are registered by the competent secretariat in the online booklet with a date not later than 10 august 2022 must be taken into consideration. Internships, laboratories, seminars and other training activities are considered valid only if registered by the secretariats in the booklet, with a date not later than 10 august 2022.

Credits are valid only if recognized for the course of study for which the student is requesting benefits. The student who has passed a degree course before the current academic year cannot include credits from validated tests in the calculation of merit.

In case of transition to another degree course, after the publication of the relative rankings, the student is included at the bottom of the ranking of the new degree course as an eligible non-beneficiary of a scholarship.

The rules listed above also apply to students with disabilities.

In exceptional cases and in any case not attributable to students, as a result of which the possibility of taking appeals is not guaranteed by the University of Messina, the ERSU of Messina will regulate any extensions for the acquisition of the required merit.

Students with disabilities and those with specific learning disabilities (SLD) in possession of suitable certification issued by public structures **must acquire the credits required in tables 5.2 and 5.4 in the appendix by 10 August 2022.**

d. Students with a three-year degree who enroll in a single-cycle master's degree course and admitted to the fourth year

They can take advantage of the benefits for two years plus the further semester starting from the fourth year of the course (for the 5-year single-cycle master's degree), or take advantage of the benefits for three years plus the further semester starting from the fourth year of course (for the 6-year single-cycle master's degree), provided that the two-year master's degree has been abolished for the course in question. They will be able to take advantage of the additional semester, provided that they have not already used it in the three-year degree. During the online procedure, they must indicate in the "Special condition" section that it is "PROSECUTION DEGREE".

Participating students will be included in separate lists and rankings with the criteria established in the following art. 19.

For the purposes of merit, students who enter the fourth year will be assessed according to the provisions for students enrolled in the first year (see TABLE 4 in the appendix), while those who access the fifth and subsequent years according to what is envisaged for students years after the first (see TABLE 5.2 and following in the appendix).

e. Bonus

If the students participating in the competition, enrolled in bachelor's or single-cycle degree courses, have not obtained the minimum number of credits required to participate in the competition, in order to achieve the merit requirements, they will be able to use, in addition to the actual credits earned, a "**bonus**", accrued in the following ways:

- Up to **5 credits** if used for the first time for the achievement of benefits for the second academic year;
- Up to **12 credits** if used for the first time for the achievement of benefits for the third academic year;
- Up to **15 credits** if used for the first time to obtain benefits for subsequent academic years.

The bonus can be used only once and cannot be combined (eg the student enrolled in the third year is entitled to 12 bonus credits and not 17). If only part of the bonus available is used, the part not used in the reference academic year can be used in subsequent years.

Students enrolled in two-year master's degree courses, for the purpose of achieving the merit requirements, can use the bonus in full (15 credits) if they have never used it.

The bonus cannot be used by students enrolled in specialization and doctoral courses.

f. Students with disabilities in conditions of gravity, referred to in Article 3, paragraph 3 of Law 104/92 or with a disability of not less than 66%, referred to in art. 14 of the Prime Ministerial Decree of April 9, 2001 or with specific learning disorders, referred to in Law 170/2010 (D.S.A.)

For students with severe disabilities, as per art. 3 paragraph 3 of Law 104/92, or with a disability of not less than 66%, pursuant to art. 14 of DPCM April 9, 2001, or affected by specific learning disorders (SLD), as per Law 170/2010, in order to take into account the objective difference in production times present in a specific disability, the possible absence, in the time of completion of the curriculum or other organizational difficulties both of the subject and of the institutions that provide the services, the merit requirement is reduced by 40%.

To compete for the scholarship, students enrolled in years subsequent to the first must have exceeded the number of credits listed in tables 5.2 and 5.4 in the appendix reduced by 40% by 10 August 2021.

For students enrolled in the first year, the merit requirements will be assessed ex post as

summarized in table 4 in the appendix.

The scholarship is awarded to students with disabilities in accordance with the provisions of Article 7; the housing service is granted for a further semester.

If students enrolled in single-cycle bachelor's or master's degree courses have not obtained the number of credits required to participate in the competition, in order to achieve the merit requirements, they can use, in addition to the credits actually obtained, a "**bonus**" (equal to 40% less than those indicated in point e) accrued in the following ways:

- up to **3 credits** if used for the first time to obtain the benefits for the second academic year;
- up to **7 credits** if used for the first time to obtain the benefits for the third academic year;
- up to **9 credits** if used for the first time to obtain benefits for subsequent academic years.

The bonus can be used only once and cannot be combined. If only part of the bonus available is used, the part not used in the reference academic year can be used in subsequent years.

Students enrolled in master's degree courses can use the bonus in full if they have never used it in order to achieve the merit requirements.

The bonus cannot be used by those enrolled in specialization and doctoral courses.

Art. 10

Reasons for exclusion

Students will be excluded from the competition who:

- are in possession of a qualification (even if obtained abroad, provided it is recognized by the University) of a level equal to or higher than the newly enrolled course of study and for which they require benefits, namely:
 - a. enrolled or who intend to enroll in a first level degree course, in possession of a university diploma (pre-reform university courses);
 - b. enrolled or who intend to enroll in a first level degree course, in possession of a first level degree;
 - c. enrolled or who intend to enroll in a first-level, master's or single-cycle master's degree course, in possession of a specialist or master's or single-cycle master's degree;
 - d. enrolled or who intend to enroll in a single-cycle master's degree course, in possession of a first level or master's degree or specialist degree;
 - e. enrolled or who intend to enroll in a first level degree course, master's degree or single cycle degree course, in possession of an old system degree (DM 509/99);
- enroll part-time in the academic year of reference of this call;
- enroll or who have enrolled by shortening the course in the academic year of reference of this call;
- attend single courses;
- are not in possession of the merit and economic-patrimonial requisites envisaged by the announcement;
- have already benefited from benefits for the same course year;
- have not validated the request for benefits with OTP within the deadlines set out in the call (only for international students and underage students);
- have not regularized the request for benefits within the terms set out in the notice;
- they have not remedied, within the period provided for the submission of the data correction / integration form, the irregularities detected ex officio and published in the lists

- of participants in the competition;
- have self-certified data that are different from what can be found in the attached documents and databases;
- have presented an irregular ISEE certificate (expired, not valid for subsidized services for the right to university study, with annotations relating to omissions / discrepancies, etc.) and which have not remedied within the period provided for the presentation of the correction form / data integration, irregularities detected ex officio and published in the lists of participants in the competition (see table 16 in the appendix);
- are in arrears due to revocation of the benefits of previous academic years and have not returned the sums received (scholarship and other monetary and non-monetary benefits);
- are not up to date with the payment of the regional tax for the right to study for the A.Y. 2021/2022;
- have included in the credit count validations of exams deriving from previous enrollments in degree courses other than the one currently attended.

Art. 11

Data processing

Before completing online and submitting the benefit request (self-certification), students must consult the privacy policy, provided for by art. 13 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 and the EU Regulation (GDPR) n. 2016/679.

By signing it, students declare that they have read the content, and in particular that:

- the personal data provided, as well as those contained in any documentation produced, will be processed, without their express consent, for institutional purposes (activities related to the management of the competition for the award of grants, other contributions and services for the right to study university, also attributable to interventions of significant public interest purposes referred to in art.68 of the Privacy Code), to fulfill the obligations established by current legislation and for statistical surveying activities;
- the particular categories of personal data (information that "... detects racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, genetic data, biometric data intended to uniquely identify a natural person, data relating to the health or sexual life or sexual orientation of the natural person ") possibly collected, recorded, stored and subsequently processed, will be relevant, complete and not excessive in relation to the purposes listed above;
- the provision of data is mandatory, under penalty of exclusion from the competition.

Personal data will not be disclosed. In the rankings, the names of the participants in the competition will be replaced by the file number of the application submitted (Web ID).

The figures responsible for guaranteeing the protection of the data provided are indicated in the application for benefits and in the information included in the appendix.

Art. 12

Investigations

On the basis of Law 127/1997 and subsequent amendments and additions, ERSU will carry out checks on what is self-certified by students with the means and methods provided for by current

legislation.

ERSU may ask students for clarification on what is declared in self-certification, even after the disbursement of benefits and will check the veracity of the statements made and the documents presented, making use of the collaboration:

- of the Revenue Agency
- of the Municipalities
- of the INPS
- of the University of Messina and of the other university institutions
- from the Guardia di Finanza or the Urban Police of the Municipality of residence of the applicant, in the case of an Italian student;
- Consulates in the case of international students or students whose family members reside abroad;
- the information system of the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of the Treasury, Budget and Economic Planning, as well as the Data Exchange System (SID), developed by the Inland Revenue on the current accounts of taxpayers;
- the information system of the Ministry of Finance and the Treasury;
- the INPS information system.

In addition, the lists of scholarship recipients will be sent to INPS for the obligations required by the decree of 8 March 2013 relating to the "Definition of the methods for strengthening the ISEE control system".

Art. 13

Withdrawal of benefits

The benefits attributed to students will be revoked who:

- a. are not regularly enrolled for the 2022/23 academic year (with the exception of the housing service, undergraduates for whom see art. 6;
- b. transfer to another university during the 2022/23 academic year **on a date prior to 17 April 2023**;
- c. renounce their studies during the 2022/23 academic year **on a date prior to 17 April 2023** (including 1st year students even if they have already met the merit requirement);
- d. do not regularize the request for benefits within the established terms;
- e. have assets and / or income that exceeds the values set out in the notice;
- f. do not have the merit required by tables 5.1, 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4;
- g. have not declared any renunciation of studies, which are decisive for the purpose of assigning benefits;
- h. first year students who have not earned the required credits by the dates indicated in table 4;
- i. are beneficiaries of scholarships or other benefits announced for the 2022/23 academic year pursuant to art. 5, without prejudice to the right of option provided for by the same article;
- j. graduate by the extraordinary session of 2021/22, even if the payment of fees for 2022/23 has been made;
- k. students who fail to meet the Administration's invitation to submit further clarifications confirming the statements made within the deadlines set in the personal communication received
- l. are found in the cases indicated in art. 10, which have occurred or which ERUS becomes

aware of later.

The revocation measure entails the obligation to return the monetary benefits and services used (scholarship, bed fee and meals according to the bracket, as per the regulations available on the website www.ersumessina.it, with the exception of relapsing cases in the following art.14, to which the provisions of the law will be applied.

Due to proven economic difficulties, the student may be granted a refund of the sums in several installments, however, within ten months of the revocation. The student is obliged to deliver to the offices of the institution a copy of the receipt proving the return.

Payments must be made through the PagoPA service, by connecting to the following link <https://secure.pmpay.it/pmPortal/noregSearchSession.do> of the institution's institutional website. Any expenses for making payments are the responsibility of the student.

Students forfeit the right to take advantage of the benefits upon graduation.

Students who lose the legal requirements for the granting of the scholarship and benefits following revocation and / or renunciation must return the equivalent value of the services used according to the following rates:

- scholarship, for the amount disbursed;
- bed, at the monthly rate of € 125,00;
- full meal, according to the income brackets provided for in art. 40 (see table 14.1 in the appendix).

Art. 14

False declarations, exclusion from benefits and penalties

Students who have been awarded the benefits who submit false declarations will have revoked the benefit attributed and will be reported to the judicial authority for the possible existence of crimes of:

- false ideology committed by the private individual in a public act (Article 438 of the Criminal Code);
- false attestation to a public official on the identity or personal qualities of one's own or of others (Article 495 of the Criminal Code);
- fraud against the State or other public body (Article 640 of the Criminal Code and subsequent amendments).

In application of Article 10 of Legislative Decree 29/03/2012 n ° 68, anyone who presents untruthful statements, whether of their own or of family members, in order to benefit from the relative interventions, is subject to an administrative sanction consisting in the payment of a sum of an amount three times the amount received, or the value of the services improperly used, and loses the right to obtain other payments for the duration of the course of studies, without prejudice in any case to the application of the sanctions referred to in article 38, paragraph 3, of the decree-law 31 May 2010, n. 78, converted, with modifications, by law 30 July 2010, n. 122, as well as the criminal laws for the facts constituting a crime.

Pursuant to Article 2946 of the Italian Civil Code (ordinary prescription), the Administration may recover, even forcibly, all sums due from students within ten years from the date of receipt of the related payment mandate.

Art. 15

Publication of participant lists

The lists of all the students participating in the competitions and the subsequent rankings will be published by the dates listed in the "Memorandum" on p. 8, on the institutional site of the ERSU of Messina www.ersumessina.it. The results of the same rankings will also be made available on the personal page of the ERSU Messina student services portal.



Participating students must pay particular attention to the notes published in the lists next to the provisional results of suspension or rejection. The ERSU does not provide any notice on the outcome of the competition directly to the students' homes.

The publication of the lists and rankings on the ERSU Messina website and the consequent availability of the results on the ERSU services personal page of the student portal constitute notification to the interested party (Article 32 paragraph 1 of Law No. 69 of 18/06/2009).

Art. 16

Corrections / additions to the data declared

Any corrections / additions to personal data or declarations made may be made by submitting the "Data correction / integration form" online, through the application available on the personal page of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal, within the deadline set for each competition, as reported in the "Memorandum" on p. 6.

To submit the "Correction / integration form, applicants for benefits must perform the following procedure:

1. **ACCESS**, in the manner indicated in art. 3, to the internet application made available on the personal page of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal;
2. **FILL IN** the required fields of the form;
3. **CONFIRM** the data entered and wait for an SMS with an OTP code for their validation (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
4. **ENTER** the OTP code received via SMS in the appropriate field to validate the data entered in the benefit request (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
5. **FINISH** the procedure.

In the event of exclusion or adjustments relating to the economic / patrimonial condition and consequent DSU, the adjustment / integration must contain an indication of the protocol number of the new ISEE certificate issued by INPS. In case of exclusion for other reasons, any other document that can heal the exclusion from the ranking must be attached to the rectification / integration.

In the event of postponement of the date of publication of the lists of participants, the period for submitting the "Data correction / integration form" is set at 10 consecutive days starting from the day of publication of the same.

For the ISEE certifications bearing the annotation of omissions or discrepancies, see table 16 in the appendix.

Art. 17

Rankings

The outcome of the competition is defined through the publication of the following types of rankings, in chronological order:

- Rankings;
- Rankings with assignee designation;
- Settled rankings.

Rankings

The **rankings** are compiled after the closing of the terms of the competition.

Upon completion of this processing, students and female students may be:

- ✓ Eligible - those who are in possession of the requisites envisaged by the notice in Articles 8 and 9;
- ✓ Rejected - those excluded from the competition falling within the cases referred to in art. 10;
- ✓ Eligible suspended - eligible who may have all the requirements to be considered as such, but that for at least one of them further verification is required; for the same, therefore, it is not yet possible to declare neither eligibility nor exclusion from the competition.

Rankings with assignee designation

In this phase, the allocation of the funds available for the competition is carried out, with the consequent designation of the assignees.

Upon completion of this processing, students and female students may be:

- ✓ Eligible assignees - those who are in possession of the requirements set out in the call for applications in Articles 8 and 9 and to whom the scholarship has been awarded;
- ✓ Eligible non-assignees - those who are in possession of the requirements set out in the call for applications in Articles 8 and 9 and to whom the scholarship has not been awarded due to the exhaustion of available resources;
- ✓ Rejected - those excluded falling within the cases referred to in art. 10;
- ✓ Eligible suspended - eligible who may have all the requirements to be considered as such, but that for at least one of them further verification is required; for the same, therefore, it is not yet possible to declare neither eligibility nor exclusion from the competition.

Rankings settled

The established rankings are compiled at the end of the university career verification operations, also in order to remove the various suspension hypotheses referred to in the previous points.

Upon completion of this processing, students may be:

- ✓ Eligible assignees - those who are in possession of the requirements set out in the call for applications in Articles 8 and 9 and for which the scholarship has been awarded;
- ✓ Eligible non-assignees - those who are in possession of the requirements set out in the call for applications in Articles 8 and 9 and for which the scholarship has not been awarded due to the exhaustion of available resources;
- ✓ Rejected - those excluded falling within the cases referred to in art. 10.

There will be no suspended students in the established rankings, with the exception of students who have participated in ERASMUS programs for which the registration of the exams taken has not yet been defined.

The rankings will be published in the same way as the "lists of participants" by the dates indicated in the "Memorandum on pag. 6".



With the publication of the rankings on the ERSU Messina website on the ERSU services personal page of the student portal, all information requirements regarding the aforementioned competition outcome are understood to be fulfilled and consequently no other communication of reference will be given to the interested parties.
For any communications contextual to the publication or subsequent ones, systems and procedures suitable for protecting the confidentiality of personal data will be adopted.

The publication of the rankings and any other competition communication will be carried out on the basis of procedures that guarantee the protection of confidentiality with reference to sensitive data, as required by current legislation on the subject. For this purpose, each student is assigned an individual code (Web ID) when applying for the verification and consultation of the relative rankings. In the ERSU services personal page of the student portal, any changes regarding the competitive position will be inserted.

In the presence of errors, the ERSU may proceed, in self-defense and / or at the request of a duly motivated party, to the readmission of students found excluded in the final rankings.

Art. 18

Appeals against the rankings

After the date of publication, appeals against the non-attribution of benefits, being the provision of a definitive nature, will be possible at the Regional Administrative Court within 60 days of the publication of the ranking.

Art. 19

Criteria for formulating the rankings

Scholarships are funded by the following funds:

- revenue from the regional tax for the right to education;
- share of the State Integrative Fund (FIS) for scholarships, made available by the M.U.R. ;
- the institution's own resources;
- additional resources, as part of the PNRR, by the EU - Next Generation EU Initiative, investment 1.7 "Scholarships for university access" of Mission 4 component 1;
- support from the PON "Research and Innovation" 2014-2020 - ESF REACT EU - TO 13 - Axis IV - Action IV.3 any other resources assigned to the Body.

These funds will be divided according to the quality of users, as indicated below:

- 1/3 to students enrolled for the first time in the three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses;
- 2/3 to students enrolled in the second and subsequent years of the three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses. The available sums will be divided among students enrolled in years subsequent to the first, in relation to the number of eligible students in the rankings of the scholarship for the A.Y. 2020/21, ensuring at least one scholarship for each degree course year.

The rankings will be formulated as follows:

- For **first-year students** of single-cycle master's degree courses, three-year degree, master's degree, doctorates, specializations, first level masters, continuation of the three-year degree

and the "A. Corelli "of Messina, all benefits are attributed on the basis of a single ranking (for each benefit), without any differentiation by university and degree courses, ordered in descending order of score calculated on the basis of the ISEE. With the same ISEE, the position in the ranking is determined in increasing order of ISPE and, subsequently, increasing in age. The following formula will be used:

$$100 * (1 - \text{ISEE declared} / \text{ISEE limit})$$

- For **students enrolled in years subsequent to the first year**, the rankings, in relation to scholarships and beds, are defined in descending order of score calculated on the basis of criteria which, taking into account the number of credits and the marks obtained, allow to make the individual merit parameters of students comparable. In case of equal merit, the position in the ranking is determined with reference to the increasing value of ISEE. With the same ISEE, the age in ascending order prevails. The following formula will be used:

$$70 * (\text{no. Of credits passed} / \text{no. Expected credits}) + 28 * (\text{arithmetic average of grades} / 30) + 0.5 * \text{no. praise (max n. 4 honors)}$$

By "expected CFU" we mean 60 CFU for those enrolling in the 2nd year, 120 CFU for those enrolling in the 3rd year, etc.

In the rankings, the bonus, if required, will be applied to the extent sufficient for the achievement of eligibility to participate while the score will be calculated on the basis of the credits actually earned, without taking into account the bonus awarded.

For the 4th graduation courses and for all courses for which it will not be possible to establish the merit parameters, the benefits will be attributed according to the income criteria as established for first year students.

The scholarship will be disbursed to students with suspended conditions only after the verification of the regularization of the obligations due, confirming the possible right to remain in the ranking of the bed assignees, if requested.

Scrolling of rankings

Following the publication of the final results, in the event of allocation of supplementary funds, these will be allocated with the same criteria set out above to suitable non-assignees up to the amount of available resources.

Notification to students of the new outcome of the competition (change from suitable non-assignee to scholarship recipient) will be given in the reserved area section of the student portal, as well as through notices published on the institution's institutional website.

Scrolling of housing service-bed rankings

After the publication of the definitive results and the assignment of the first acceptance beds, if beds remain unassigned, these will be assigned with the same criteria set out above to suitable non-assignees of bed places (therefore renouncers and lapsed persons will be excluded. of bed) up to the amount of bed places available for competition.

Given the small number of accommodation places available, for students of years subsequent to the first the allocation of accommodation will be carried out in descending order of score, regardless of the degree course of enrollment and the year of the course attended.

The communication to students of the new outcome of the competition (change from suitable non-assignee to assignee of a bed) will also be published in the reserved area section of the student portal, as well as through notices published on the institutional website.

PART TWO Scholarships

Art. 20

Application submission procedure – Distribution criteria

To submit the request for "scholarship and housing service" it is necessary to follow the following procedure:

1. **ACCESS** the internet application made available in the reserved area of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal as indicated below:
 - a) adult students in possession of an identity document issued by the Italian authorities (eg identity card) and international students who declare residence in Italy, access the reserved area with SPID or CIE;
 - b) international students in possession exclusively of an identity document issued by the authorities of their country and not resident in Italy, access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register on first access);
 - c) underage students access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register on first access);
2. **FILL** in the mandatory fields of the form from **15 july 2022 to 2,00 pm on 31 august 2022**;
3. **CONFIRM** the data entered and wait for an SMS with an OTP code for their validation (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
4. **VALIDATE** the data entered in the benefit request by reporting the OTP code received via SMS in the appropriate field (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
5. **FINISH** the procedure.

Technical assistance and answers to questions sent by e-mail will be guaranteed **until 13:00 on 31 august 2022**.

Once all the applications received have been examined, the ERSU of Messina will publish the lists of scholarship participants on **21 september 2022**.

From **21 september 2022 al 30 september 2022 by 2:00 pm** it will be possible to present any appeals and / or corrections, using the online procedure for both scholarships and housing services, and upload (upload) in a single file format ".pdf" the correction documentation required by the announcement.

By **17 november 2022**, scholarship requests from other Bodies must be received by ERSU in Messina.

By **31 december 2022 at 2:00 pm** the request for participation in the competition for the assignment of the scholarship and the avitative service must be regularized.

Once all the appeals and / or corrections received and the scholarship requests from other Bodies have been examined, the ERSU of Messina will publish the ranking with the designation

of the scholarship recipients on **19 november 2022**.

The ranking of the scholarship for students enrolled in years subsequent to the first will be published by **30 june 2023**.

The ranking of the scholarship for students enrolled in the first year will be published by **31 december 2022**.



The student who wishes to request **the "incoming" transfer of the scholarship** application submitted to other institutions for the right to study, must submit an application to the institution to which he / she belongs, which must be sent exclusively by certified e-mail, to the following address e-mail direttore@pec.ersu.me.it, the application and the accompanying documentation by **November 17, 2022**, under penalty of exclusion, with the subject "Transfer request for A.Y. benefits 2021/22 ", provided that the original application for participation has been submitted by the deadline of 31 august 2022, provided for in this call.

The request **for "incoming" transfer of the scholarship** application submitted to other Bodies for the right to study will not be accepted if it is received after the publication of the scholarship ranking.

The Entity declines all responsibility if the documentation is received after the date indicated above.

Exceptions are degree courses for which a national ranking is envisaged, i.e. Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry, Veterinary Medicine, Health Professions, Primary Education Sciences, for which the allocation of places is carried out in a balanced way between structural coefficients provided by the Universities. and labor market needs provided by the state and the regions.

The student who wishes to request **the "outgoing" transfer of the scholarship** application presented to the ERSU of Messina, must submit an application to the ERSU of Messina using the appropriate online application available on the personal page of the "ersuonline" services of the portal students, available at the link <http://studenti.ersumessina.it/login.php>. The ERSU of Messina will automatically transmit the same to the destination body, disclaiming any responsibility in the event that it is not accepted.

During the distribution of the scholarships, according to the provisions of the previous art. 19, the reserve of scholarships listed in table 2 in the appendix will be taken into account, without prejudice to the economic and merit requirements specified in art. 8 and 9, regulated as follows:

- ✓ to all students with severe disabilities, as referred to in Article 3, paragraph 1 and 3 of Law 104/92 and / or with a recognized disability of not less than 66%, as referred to in art. 14 of the Prime Ministerial Decree of April 9, 2001;
- ✓ up to a maximum of n. 54 scholarships reserved for internationals from particularly poor countries, as per table 8 in the appendix, or for political refugees entitled to international protection;
- ✓ fi up to a maximum of n. 15 scholarships reserved for orphans of victims of work who, on 10.8.2021, are in possession of the INAIL declaration stating that the parent died due to work causes;
- ✓ up to a maximum of n. 3 scholarships reserved for international children of Sicilian emigrants abroad who as of 10.08.2021 have been resident abroad for at least 5 years with their entire family;

- ✓ up to a maximum of n. 2 scholarships reserved for orphans victims for mafia reasons who produce the appropriate certification issued by the competent Prefecture. It is incompatible with providences of the same type;
 - ✓ up to a maximum of n. 5 scholarships reserved for victims of usury or children of victims of usury who produce the appropriate certification issued by the competent Prefecture;
 - ✓ up to a maximum of n. 15 scholarships reserved for residents, for at least 5 years on 10.8.2021, in the smaller islands falling within the territory of the Sicilian Region;
 - ✓ up to a maximum of n. 10 scholarships reserved for orphans or students without parental responsibility following a court order, who demonstrate, with appropriate documentation, that they are guests or have been hosted in a public or private reception facility.
- Reserved scholarships will be assigned, within the limits set out in table 2 and the available economic resources, on the basis of rankings formulated as indicated below:
 - - for first-year students and female students, the benefits are attributed on the basis of a single ranking, without any differentiation by study courses, ordered in descending order of score calculated on the basis of the ISEE. With the same score, the position in the ranking is determined in increasing order of ISPE and, subsequently, increasing in age. To determine the score, the formula indicated in the previous art. 19.
 - - for students of years subsequent to the first, the benefits are attributed on the basis of a single ranking, without any differentiation for courses of study and year of course. The rankings are defined in descending order of score calculated on the basis of criteria which, taking into account the number of credits and the marks obtained, make it possible to make the individual merit parameters of the students comparable. In case of equal merit, the position in the ranking is determined with reference to the increasing value of ISEE. With the same score, the position in the ranking is determined in increasing order of ISPE and, subsequently, increasing in age. To determine the score, the formula indicated in the previous art. 19.

Art. 21

Criteria for determining the amounts

The amounts of the scholarships, pending the definitive implementation of art. 7, paragraph 7, of Legislative Decree 68/2012, are defined by the D.M. 1320/2021 which, with respect to the current amounts as most recently identified by the MUR with D.M. February 12, 2021, n. 157 (euro 5,257.74 "off-site students", euro 2,898.51 "commuter students", euro 1,981.75 "on-site students"), an average increase of euro 700.00 for the reference period of the PNRR (2021 - 2026) from the academic year 2022/2023 until the academic year 2025/2026. In particular:

- for "off-site" students and "independent" students the amount of € 5.257,74 is increased by € 900.00, **so as to determine the total amount of € 6.157,74;**

- for "commuter" students the amount of € 2,898.51 is increased by € 700.00, **so as to determine the total amount of € 3.598,51;**
- for "on-site" students the amount of € 1,981.75 is increased by € 500.00, **so as to determine the total amount of € 2.481,75.**

The total amount of the scholarship (hereinafter "BS"), as defined above by current legislation, is given by the sum of the monetary portion relating to the actual scholarship (hereinafter "bs"), the monetary portion relating to the housing service (hereinafter "sa") and the monetary portion relating to the catering service (hereinafter "sr"):

$$BS = bs + sa + sr$$

The total amount of the scholarship is reduced by the monetary amount relating to the catering service in the event that students enjoy one / two meals a day free of charge at the institution's catering outlets.

The total amount of the scholarship for "off-site" students is reduced by the monetary amount relating to the housing service in the event that the students make free use of the bed at a university residence of the institution.

The amount of the scholarship to be paid (bs), therefore, is given by the total amount of the scholarship (BS) net of the deductions of any sums corresponding to the value of the services used for free (housing service and catering service):

$$bs = BS - sa - sr$$

Amount of the scholarship in relation to income

With reference to the combined provisions of art. 3, paragraph 3, of the D.M. n. 1320/2021, which introduces a 15% increase in the scholarship for students with ISEE levels below 50% of the maximum reference limit, and art. 3, paragraph 8, which (reiterating the provisions of art.9, paragraph 6, of the D.P.C.M. of 09/04/2001) establishes that the amount of the scholarship is paid in full to students whose ISEE is less than 2 / 3 of the maximum reference limit, in compliance with the principle of the progressivity of the value of the scholarships, the table included in the Ministerial Circular explaining the Ministerial Decree is shown below. 1320/2021, which specifies the value of the scholarships according to the ISEE range of reference.

Increases and reductions

The basic amount of the scholarship referred to in the previous table is:

- a. **increased by 15%** if the value of the equivalent economic situation indicator (ISEE) is less than or equal to half the ISEE limit, as indicated in the first row of the table above;
- b. **increased by 40%** to people with disabilities pursuant to article 3, paragraphs 1 and 3, of law no. 104, and / or with a disability equal to or greater than 66%;
- c. **increased by 20%** to female students enrolled in the CdS in S.T.E.M. subjects;
- d. **increased by 20%** for students enrolled simultaneously in two courses of study at different universities and / or AFAM institutes;
- e. **reduced by 50%** for students enrolled in the first non-course (for all scholarships, including reserved ones);
- f. **reduced by 50%** for people with disabilities pursuant to article 3, paragraphs 1 and 3, of law no. 104, and / or with a disability equal to or greater than 66%, enrolled in the second out of course;
- g. **reduced by 50%** for first year students who do not achieve at least n. 15 credits by 08/10/2023 and at least n. 20 as of 11/30/2023, but only n. 20 credits by 11/30/2023;
- h. **reduced ex officio** of any sums corresponding to the value of the services used free of charge (housing service and restaurant service);
- i. **increased by 50%** in the event that the assignee achieves the degree within the duration provided for by the respective teaching systems, so-called "Degree award". This increase will be recognized only in case of exhaustion of the rankings of suitable candidates and availability of additional economic resources with respect to the scholarships;
- j. **reduced ex officio** of the amounts possibly due to the Entity for any reason (pending arrears, damages, etc.).

The increases and reductions are carried out automatically by the institution, proceeding with any checks with the universities / AFAM institutes.

The increase referred to in letter c. it cannot be combined with the increase referred to in letter a. and, therefore, in the event of an ISEE value less than or equal to 50% ISEE limit, this increase is calculated on the basis of the value of the stock exchange due (€ 6,157.74; € 3,598.51; € 2,481.75).

With the exception of the hypothesis of incumulation described above, the other hypotheses of increase / reduction are calculated on each scholarship amount shown in table 9 in the appendix and the individual increases / reductions are added together algebraically.

The share of the scholarship provided in services (canteen and accommodation) cannot be monetized and, in case of non-use, it will not give the right to any reimbursement.

For any further details, please refer to table 9 in the appendix to the announcement.

Art. 22

Status of claimants based on residency

For the purposes of awarding the scholarship, applicants for benefits are considered, in relation to their residence and with respect to the educational center attended, as:

- "headquarter";
- "commuters";
- "Offsite".

In general, pursuant to art. 4 paragraph 8 of the D.P.C.M. dated 09/04/2001, the following are considered:

- "on site", the residents in the municipality or in the area surrounding the seat of the degree course they are enrolled in (see table 11.1 in the appendix);
- "commuters", residents in a place that allows daily transfer to the location of the course of study attended (see table 11.2 in the appendix);
- "off-site", residents in a place distant from the seat of the degree course attended and who for this reason are staying in a university residence managed by the ENT or demonstrating that they are staying for a fee near that location, for a period not less than ten months, using public residential facilities or other private or corporate housing. However, this status must be documented as specified in Article 23.

For international students whose family unit resides in Italy, the same rules apply as for Italian students referred to in the previous points. International students whose family unit does not reside in Italy will still be considered "off-site", in accordance with the provisions of art. 13.3 of the D.P.C.M. April 9, 2001 (see table 9 in the appendix).

Art. 23

Lease declaration

In the absence of an agreement with accommodation facilities and limited to the A.Y. 2022/2023 students who are "off-site" winners who attend the branch offices of Noto, Priolo and Reggio Calabria, who take up accommodation in private and / or public facilities for a fee, for a period of not less than ten, can submit a rental declaration. months. The ERSU, in the absence of an agreement with local catering companies and limited to the A.Y. in progress, in this case increases the scholarship, by the following amounts:

- € 1,200.00 if "off-site" winners, pursuant to art. 22, who attend the branch offices of Noto, Priolo and Reggio Calabria;
- € 600.00 if winners "on site" and "commuters" pursuant to art. 22.

Students found to be "eligible not beneficiaries" of the scholarship, who attend the branch offices listed above, may in any case submit the aforementioned declaration of the previous paragraph. This will allow them to acquire the status of "off-site" and to receive the rent contribution only in case of transition from the status of "suitable" to that of "winner", in the event of scrolling of the scholarship ranking for assignment of additional funds from the Ministry.

Students who attend the University of Messina and who reside over 45 km from it can also submit a rental declaration, pursuant to art. 22, who, finding themselves in particular situations, take up accommodation in private and / or public structures, for consideration, for a period of not less than ten months. Exceptional cases are understood to mean all those cases that involve the student's need to stay near the venue of the course attended due to particular inconveniences (e.g. single mother with a minor child, severe disability even with a chaperone,

etc.). The aforementioned particular situations must be properly documented and will be evaluated by a specific commission of this body. In this case, the ERSU also recognizes two free full meals in addition to the rent contribution.

Students who attend the University of Messina and who reside over 45 km from it, pursuant to art. 22, which not being in particular situations, to obtain the rent contribution must firstly compete for the allocation of accommodation at the ERSU residences in Messina using the online procedure and clicking on the appropriate item "housing service".

Only after the completion of the phase of delivery of the accommodation to the beneficiaries, the students found to be eligible non-beneficiaries in the ranking of the accommodation place due to exhaustion of the places in the Student Houses, in order to recognize the rent contribution, must submit by 14:00 of 09 / 01/2023 the lease declaration relating to the rental of an accommodation with private individuals in the manner indicated in the previous paragraph.

Pending the definition of the above procedures, students will be included in the ranking with the designation of the scholarship recipients in any case with the status of "commuter" students and they will be paid the first installment by 31/12/2022. Only after the presentation of the rental contract, after verifying its validity, will the rent contribution be paid together with the balance of the scholarship calculated as an "off-site" student. In addition, two free meals and one free meal for on-site and commuter students will be assigned to "off-site" students attending the Messina campus.

Students who do not require accommodation at the ERSU Residences of Messina because they already have a regular rental contract will still have to submit the rental declaration in the manner provided above. Once the validity of the documentation submitted has been verified, they will be granted the status of "off-site" student and will only benefit from the integration of the "commuter" to "off-site" scholarship and the second free full meal.

The contribution linked to the rental declaration is paid only to those entitled, winners of the scholarship, who have submitted the required documentation, as also indicated in table 9 and precisely € 1,250.00.

The lease declaration must refer to a lease contract in the name or joint name of the person requesting benefits, duly registered, covering a period of at least 10 months between 1 September 2022 and 31 October 2023.

To submit the "Tenancy Declaration", applicants for benefits must perform the following procedure:

1. **ACCESS** the internet application made available in the reserved area of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal as indicated below:
 - a) adult students in possession of an identity document issued by the Italian authorities (eg. Identity card) and international students who declare residence in Italy, access the reserved area with SPID or CIE;
 - b) international students in possession exclusively of an identity document issued by the authorities of their country and not resident in Italy, access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register at first access);
 - c) underage students access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register on first access);
2. **FILL** in the mandatory fields of the form from **31 october 2022 to 2:00 pm**

on 9 January 2023;

3. **CONFIRM** the data entered and wait for an SMS with an OTP code for their validation (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
4. **VALIDATE** the data entered in the benefit request by reporting the OTP code received via SMS in the appropriate field (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
5. **FINISH** the procedure.

Technical assistance and answers to questions sent by e-mail will be guaranteed **until 1:00 pm on 9 January 2023.**



Those who have submitted the Lease Declaration are required to upload a copy of the duly registered rental contract and a receipt for the renewal / extension of the contract which shows the payment of the registration tax. In addition, they must notify ERSU of any changes to the contract (early termination or elements included in the contract), under penalty of exclusion from the additional portion of the benefit.

Art. 24

Method of disbursement of the scholarship

The cash part of the scholarship is paid, compatibly with the own financial resources available and with the regular remittances of funds by the University Institutions (reimbursement of the Regional Tax for the right to study), the share of the State Supplementary Fund of the MUR (FIS), the European Union Next Generation EU Initiative (additional resources, as part of the PNRR, investment 1.7 "Scholarships for access to the University" of Mission 4 component 1) and the support of the PON " Research and Innovation "2014-2020 - ESF REACT EU - OT 13 - Axis IV - Action IV.3, as well as any other resources assigned to the Entity in two solutions (deposit and balance), as follows:

First installment (down payment)

The first installment of the amount due for the scholarship as an "on-site" or "commuter" student, as they do not yet have the required minimum credits, to the first year, fourth year recipients "Will be paid to the extent of 50%, **by 31 December 2022** or after the regularization of any suspended application and in any case only after university enrollment for the A.Y. 2022/2023.

For first-year assignees enrolled in specialization courses and research doctorates, the first installment of the amount due for the scholarship as an "on-site" or "commuter" student will be paid in the amount of 50%, **by 31 December 2022** or after the regularization of any suspended application and in any case only after university enrollment for the A.Y. 2022/2023.

To the assignees of years subsequent to the first, the first installment of the amount due for the scholarship as an "on-site" or "commuter" student, will be paid in the amount of 50%, **by 31 December 2022** or after the regularization of the request, if any suspended and in any

case only after university enrollment for the A.Y. 2022/2023.



Non-on-site assignees will be temporarily assigned the status of "commuter", with consequent payment of the first installment of the scholarship according to the amount provided for this status (see table 9).

Following the presentation of the rental declaration (see art. 23) or the acceptance of the bed, the student will acquire the status of "off-site" and therefore the right to receive the balance according to this status.

Second installment payment (balance)

The balance of 50% of the scholarship will be paid to the assignees of the first year, fourth year pursuing a three-year degree and first level master's degree following the achievement of a minimum of 15 university training credits on 10 August 2023 and on achievement of a minimum of 20 (e.g. 15 + 5) training credits by 30 November 2023 (Art. 6 paragraph 1 and 3 D.P.C.M. 09/04/2001).

If they have acquired only 20 CFU by November 30, 2023 and not even 15 CFU by August 10, 2023, recognized for the enrollment study course and registered by the student secretaries, they will keep the benefits granted (first installment of the scholarship and meals consumed).

If they have not acquired at least 20 ECTS by November 30, 2023, recognized for the enrollment study course and registered by the student secretariats, the benefits will be revoked, with return of the scholarship, housing service and catering service.

For first-year assignees with disabilities, the balance of 50% of the scholarship will be paid following the achievement of a minimum of 9 university training credits on 10 August 2023 and the achievement of a minimum of 12 credits (e.g. 9 +3) training by 30 November 2023 (Art. 6 paragraph 1 and 3 D.P.C.M. 09/04/2001).

If they have not acquired the 9 ECTS by 10 August 2023, but have acquired 12 ECTS by 30 November 2023, recognized for the enrollment course of study and registered by the student secretaries, they will retain the benefits granted (first installment of the scholarship study and meals consumed).

If they have not acquired at least 12 ECTS by November 30, 2023, recognized for the enrollment study course and registered by the student secretary, the benefits will be revoked, with return of the scholarship, housing service and catering service.

The second installment of the final scholarship will be paid by 30/06/2023 to first-year assignees enrolled in specialization courses and research doctorates, subject to verification of regular registration with the University of Messina for the A.Y. 2022/2023.

The disbursement of the balance to first-year assignees, compatibly with their own economic resources and with the regular remittances of funds by the university institutions (payment of the regional tax for the right to study), of the M.U.R. (share of the State Supplementary Fund - FIS) and any other resources assigned to the Entity, is expected by **31 December 2023**.

To the assignees of years subsequent to the first, who, following verification by the ENT, prove to have achieved the merit declared and provided for in tables 5.1 and 5.3, compatibly with their own economic resources and with the regular remittances of funds by the University Institutions (payment of the regional tax for the right to study), of the M.U.R. (share of the State Supplementary Fund - FIS) and any other resources assigned to the body, the balance will be paid by **30 June 2023**.

To the assignees of years subsequent to the first with disabilities, who, following verification by the ENT, prove to have achieved the merit declared and provided for in tables 5.2 and 5.4, compatibly with their own economic resources and with the regular remittances of funds to be

part of the University Institutions (payment of the regional tax for the right to study), of the M.U.R. (share of the State Supplementary Fund - FIS) and any other resources assigned to the institution, the balance will be paid by **30 June 2023**.

Undergraduates who graduate within the extraordinary session of the A.Y. 2022/2023 (maximum expected 30/04/2023) but during the A.Y. 2021/22, will not receive any monetary benefits and will forfeit any benefits attributed with reserve.

Undergraduates who do not graduate by the extraordinary session of the A.Y. 2022/2023 (maximum expected 30/04/2023) and, therefore, will enroll in the first semester out of the course, will receive the scholarship, equal to half the amount of the corresponding scholarship, by **30 June 2023**.

Undergraduates who graduate within the extraordinary session relating to the academic year 2022/23 (maximum expected 30/04/2023) and who enroll for the academic year 2022/23 in the first year of a master's course, will receive the first installment of the scholarship by **30 June 2023**.

Art. 25

Terms of payment

For the purposes of traceability of financial flows and better management of the disbursement service, payments will be made exclusively:

- by crediting a bank or postal current account with an IBAN code in the name or joint name of the student;
- by crediting a prepaid card with an IBAN code in the student's name or joint name.



It will be the student's responsibility to present suitable documentation certifying ownership of the current account.

Make sure that the prepaid card or any other bank or postal means allows for the credit transfer of the amounts provided for in the competition announcement.

Postal books are not allowed because, even if they have an IBAN, they cannot receive wire transfers.

Payment by direct receipt is not permitted.

Those who encounter difficulties in collecting the provisions issued in their name, must promptly notify the Entity in writing or by email.

The payment is suspended for the assignees who must regularize their position.

The benefits will also be revoked ex officio to those who, within 12 months of assignment of the same, will not communicate the IBAN code necessary for the payment of sums exceeding € 1,000.00 to the Entity.

The payment status will be published in the appropriate section of the personal page of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal.



After twelve months from the issuance of the payment order, the amounts due will lapse.

Art. 26

Reimbursement of the Regional Tax for the right to study

The reimbursement of the regional tax for the right to study will be made ex officio to the assignees and eligible non-assignees of the scholarship.

This sum will be disbursed, compatibly with the availability of financial resources, with a specific payment **by 31 december 2023** for the assignees / eligible of the first and subsequent years.

The payment status will be published in the appropriate section of the personal page of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal.



The institution does not provide any notice on the reimbursement of the regional tax directly to the students' homes. **The publication on the personal "ersuonline" services page of the student portal constitutes notification to the interested party** (Article 32 paragraph 1 of Law no. 69 of 18/06/2009).

The regional tax will not be refunded to those whose benefits have been revoked.



The competence for any exemption and / or refund of university fees (with the exception of the regional tax only) lies with the university institutions.

PART THREE

Other economic contributions

Art. 27

Other economic contributions

By "other economic contributions" we mean:

- ✓ contributions for international mobility.
- ✓ integration for graduates (degree award).

Without prejudice to the requirements set out in the competition notice, students requesting these benefits must produce the appropriate documentation for each benefit requested.

The contributions referred to in this article are compatible with the other benefits provided by the Entity.

They will be assigned within the limits set out in table 2 in the appendix and the economic resources available.

Art. 28

Contribution for internazionale mobility

Having taken note of what is indicated in the notes prot. 1119 / GAB of 6/3/2020 and prot. 1680 of 21/4/2020 by the Regional Councilor for Education and Vocational Training regarding the management of financial resources dedicated to the integration of scholarships for international mobility, for the A.Y. 2022/2023 this body commits the amounts provided for in favor of outgoing students (equal to a maximum of 4% of the economic resources assigned to the Call) for the disbursement of contributions in favor of incoming students from countries in the MENA area and in any case from countries extra-EU.

The ERSU reserves the right to define, with a subsequent provision, the methods of participation, the admission criteria, amounts, formulation of rankings for the complete definition of the procedure.

Art. 29

Integration for "degree prize" graduates

Once the ranking of students eligible for the scholarship has been completed and within the limits of financial resources, in any case within the limit of € 75,000.00, the "degree prize" will be granted to supplement the scholarship, reserved for scholarship recipients for the AA 2021/22 who obtain the three-year degree, two-year master's degree and single-cycle master's degree within the duration established by the respective teaching regulations.

The contribution can be granted only once in the career. Therefore students who have already benefited or who intend to benefit from this contribution for the achievement of the Bachelor's Degree cannot request it for the achievement of the two-year Master's Degree. That is, students who have not already benefited from this contribution for the achievement of the Bachelor's Degree may request it for the achievement of the two-year Master's Degree. To submit the request for the "degree award", it is necessary to perform the following procedure:

1. **ACCESS** the internet application made available in the reserved area of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal as indicated below:
 - a) adult students in possession of an identity document issued by the Italian authorities (eg. Identity card) and international students who declare residence in Italy, access the reserved area with SPID or CIE;
 - b) international students in possession exclusively of an identity document issued by the authorities of their country and not resident in Italy, access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register at first access);
2. **FILL** in the mandatory fields of the form **from 3 April 2023 to 14:00 on 3 May 2023**;
3. **CONFIRM** the data entered and wait for an SMS with an OTP code for their validation (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
4. **VALIDATE** the data entered in the benefit request by reporting the OTP code received via SMS in the appropriate field (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
5. **FINISH** the procedure.

Technical assistance and answers to questions sent by e-mail will be guaranteed **until 13:00 on 3 May 2023**.

The amounts of the contribution for graduates are indicated in table 9 bis in the appendix.

On **24 May 2023** the lists of participants of the degree award will be published.

From **24 May 2023** until **7 June 2023 at 2.00 pm** it will be possible to send rectification / integration of the data declared in the request to participate in the competition by email to borsedistudio@ersu.me.it

On **28 June 2023** the ranking of the degree award will be published with the designation of the assignees.

The benefit will be disbursed only after the verification, by the office in charge, of the qualification obtained, within the limits of the reserve percentage provided for in table 2 in the appendix and without prejudice to the availability of the institution based on the formulation of a ranking. To obtain the degree award, the ranking is formulated in descending order with respect to the degree grade achieved and, with the same score, in ascending order with respect to the ISEE value, 0.50 points are attributed to honors. With the above parameters being equal, the ISPE value and age are taken into consideration, respectively, both in ascending order.

PART FOUR

Housing service

Art. 30

Characteristics of benefit

The organization offers the possibility to participants in the call for applications regularly enrolled at the University of Messina (with the exception of "on-site" students, as per table 11.1 in the appendix and "commuter" students, referred to in table 11.2 in the appendix), to request the assignment of a bed and to stay in one of the university residences managed by ERSU Messina.

The housing service can be requested in the manner set out in art. 3, together with the scholarship application. If, on the other hand, only the scholarship has been requested, it will also be possible to request the housing service by submitting the "Data correction / integration form", in the manner and within the times indicated in art. 16.

Art. 31

How to participate

To submit the request for "housing service" it is necessary to follow the following procedure:

1. **ACCESS** the internet application made available in the reserved area of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal as indicated below:
 - a) adult students in possession of an identity document issued by the Italian authorities (eg. Identity card) and international students who declare residence in Italy, access the reserved area with SPID or CIE;
 - b) international students in possession exclusively of an identity document issued by the authorities of their country and not resident in Italy, access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register at first access);
 - c) underage students access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register on first access);
2. **FILL** in the mandatory fields of the form from **15 july 2022 alle ore 14:00 del 31 august 2022**;
3. **CONFIRM** the data entered and wait for an SMS with an OTP code for their validation (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
4. **VALIDATE** the data entered in the benefit request by reporting the OTP code received via SMS in the appropriate field (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
5. **FINISH** the procedure.

Technical assistance and answers to questions sent by e-mail will be guaranteed **until 13:00 on 31 august 2022**.

Once all the applications received have been examined, the ERSU of Messina will publish the lists of participants in the housing service on **21 september 2022**.

From 21 september 2022 al 30 september 2022 by 14:00 it will be possible to present any appeals and / or corrections, using the online procedure for both scholarships and housing services, and upload (upload) in a single file format ".pdf" the correction documentation required by the announcement.

By 7 october 2022, requests for housing services from other Bodies must be sent to the ERSU of Messina.

Once all the appeals and / or corrections received have been examined, the ERSU of Messina will publish the ranking with the designation assignees of the housing service on **10 october 2022**.

The schedule for assigning free accommodation places will be published by **14 october 2022**.



The student wishing to request the "incoming" transfer of the housing service application submitted to other institutions for the right to study, must submit an application to the institution to which he / she belongs, which must be sent exclusively by certified e-mail, to the following address of e-mail director@pec.ersu.me.it, the application and the accompanying documentation by 7 October 2022, under penalty of exclusion, with the subject "Transfer of the request for A.Y. 2022/23 ", provided that the original application for participation was submitted by the deadline of August 31, 2022, provided for in this call.

If the request for "incoming" transfer of the scholarship application submitted to other Bodies for the right to study should be received after the publication of the housing service ranking, the latter cannot be granted.

Exceptions are degree courses for which a national ranking is envisaged, i.e. Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry, Veterinary Medicine, Health Professions, Primary Education Sciences, for which the allocation of places is carried out in a balanced way between structural coefficients provided by the Universities. and labor market needs provided by the state and the regions.

The Entity declines all responsibility if the documentation is received after the date indicated above.

The student who wishes to request the "outgoing" transfer of the scholarship application presented to the ERSU of Messina, must submit an application to the ERSU of Messina using the appropriate online application available on the personal page of the "ersuonline" services of the portal students, accessible from the link <https://studenti.ersumessina.it>. The ERSU of Messina will automatically send it to the destination body, disclaiming any responsibility in the event that it is not accepted.

Art. 32

Distribution criteria

The available beds will be divided as follows:

- 1/5 to students enrolled for the first time in three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses;
- 4/5 for students enrolled in the second and subsequent years of the three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses.

The beds, a total of n. 298 for the Messina campus, intended for students with a degree course in Messina, will be divided as follows (see table 15 in the appendix):

- No. 82 (there were 77) at the Papardo residence;
- No. 86 (there were 83) at the Annunziata residence;
- 130 places at the Gravitelli Residence.

The subdivision referred to in the previous paragraph is not binding for the ERSU as it is subject to the actual availability of seats.

The distribution of the 298 accommodation places will take place as follows:

- 15 reserved accommodation places, up to a maximum of 5% of the available places, divided as follows:

- 5 places for disabled students at the Gravitelli residence;
- 2 places for disabled students at the Papardo residence;
- 1 place for disabled students at the Annunziata residence;
- 3 places for students residing for at least five years in the smaller islands of Sicily;
- 2 places for international students from particularly poor non-EU countries, as per table 8 in the appendix, or for political refugees, entitled to international protection;
- 2 places for students who are orphans or without parental responsibility following a court order, who demonstrate that they are guests or have been guests in public or private reception facilities.

The beds for reservations referred to in the previous points will be equally divided between the "first year" and "subsequent years" students, with in any case the purpose of assigning all the reserved accommodation.

- n ° 275 accommodation places, divided as follows:

- 1/5 to students enrolled for the first time in three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses;
- 4/5 for students enrolled in the second and subsequent years of the three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses.

If it is not possible to assign the beds according to the above subdivision due to the limitations deriving from the social distancing resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, we will communicate the beds actually available at the time of publication of the lists of scholarship participants on **September 21, 2022**.

Art. 33

Use of the bed

Bed assignees can take advantage of the benefit from the moment of acceptance and until October 14, 2023, with the exception of the following periods:

or from 19/12/2022 to 06/01/2023 (closing for Christmas holidays)
or from 24/07/2023 to 03/09/2023 (summer closure)

Any additions, exceptions or changes to the periods and days of the week provided for in this and in the previous paragraph, will be communicated by this Body through notices published on the bulletin board and on the website www.ersumessina.it

Unless otherwise specified, which in any case will be exceptional, in the periods provided above, as this body must guarantee cultural exchanges, the accommodations must be cleared

of the assignees and any personal belongings.

Upon returning from the summer closure, the student will not be allowed to re-enter the housing facilities in the absence of a valid application for the following academic year; therefore, the student's stay at the facilities will be considered concluded on 24 July 2023.

Bed assignees in the A.Y. 2021/2022, which should be suitable but not assignees of the bed for the A.Y. 2022/2023, they must leave the bed occupied in one of the University Residences within five days of the publication of the final ranking of bed places, under penalty of forfeiture of all benefits and services provided by the ERSU.

Graduating assignees must leave their accommodation within 5 days from the date of graduation.

Art. 34

Assignment of the bed

Students are admitted to the residences according to the order of precedence established in the rankings and must take possession of the accommodation within five days from the date scheduled for assignment, under penalty of forfeiture of the right. ERSU reserves the right to transfer from one university residence to another for justified reasons.



Scholarship recipients who must apply for the housing service but who are not eligible for the benefit due to unavailability of beds, will be granted an additional economic contribution to the scholarship or rent contribution, equal to € 1,250.00, as an additional service fee. A condition that must present a regular "Declaration of lease" in the housing modalities and in the terms indicated in art. 23.

Scholarship recipients will not have requested the housing service or who have renounced the housing service or who have not renounced the bed or who will be forfeited, will not be entitled to the supplementary share of the housing service.

Art. 35

Terms for acceptance of the bed

The assignees of the first year and subsequent years, who are not guests of the University Residences, must accept the benefit **within 5 days from the date scheduled for assignment, under penalty of forfeiture of the benefit.**

With the publication of the list of bed places on the institutional website of the Entity, all information requirements regarding the aforementioned competition outcome are considered fulfilled and no other communication of reference will be made to the interested parties.

Assigned students who, for justified reasons of study (participation in international mobility programs) and / or serious personal reasons, will not be able to accept by the deadline mentioned above, must send to the e-mail address ufficio.residenze@ersu.me.it, specific justification before the acceptance deadline.

For the purpose of a full distribution of the beds put up for competition, after the publication of the rankings, the bed assignee will not be able to renounce this benefit and at the same time

opt for the delivery of the rental declaration for the purpose of assigning the rent contribution (see also art.23 of the announcement).

Students who, despite having expressed an interest in assigning a bed, will not be eligible for the assignment of the benefit due to unavailability of places, will be able to take advantage of the supplementary financial contribution or rent contribution only if they are scholarship winners and without prejudice to the availability of the funds of the Entity.

Art. 36

Methods of acceptance of the bed

To accept the bed, the following documents must be delivered to the residence of assignment:

- a. medical certificate issued by the family doctor (affiliated with SSN) or by any ASP (former ASL) on a date not earlier than 15 days, certifying that the applicant (student) does not suffer from diseases that affect coexistence in the community;
- b. receipt of the payment of € 150.00, to be made, in the manner prescribed by law, through the PagoPa service, by connecting to the link <https://secure.pmpay.it/pmPortal/noreqSearchSession.do?codCompany=PA821> of the institutional website of the institution, as a security deposit, required to preventively cover any damage that the student could cause to the property of the institution. After verification by this institution of any damage caused by the student to the accommodation or relevant structures of the residences, the security deposit is returned in whole or in part at the end of the academic year;
- c. any health documentation, if required by law, based on the evolution of the pandemic situation from Covid-19;
- d. receipt of payment of the accommodation fee 2022/2023, if due (see following article 38);
- e. photocopy of the residence permit for non-EU students or a copy of the payment for its renewal;
- f. photocopy of a valid identity document.

Failure to observe even one of the previous points of this paragraph does not allow the taking of possession of the accommodation until the completion of the requirements, which must take place within five days from the date scheduled for assignment.

If the student benefits from a scholarship within the "Erasmus" project, he is required to notify this institution well in advance and for the entire period of use he will lose the use of the accommodation. For the whole of the aforementioned period, the student must free the accommodation of all their personal items since ERSU will be able to use the accommodation to guarantee the service to other students.

The Managers of the University Residences will be able to allow the interested party to access and consequently take possession of the accommodation only after all the required documentation has been acquired.

Art. 37

Expression of interest in the bed

In order to have a full and rapid distribution of the beds put up for competition, once the terms

for accepting accommodation at the ERSU residences have closed, all students who are eligible in the ranking for "housing service" must express their real interest in assigning the bed, as detailed below:

- for first-year students who have expressed interest in the housing service, a single ranking will be drawn up, without any differentiation by school and degree course, ordered in descending order of scores calculated on the basis of the ISEE (score detected by scholarship ranking). With the same ISEE, the position in the ranking is determined in ascending order of ISPE and, subsequently, increasing in age (see formula art. 19);
- for students of years subsequent to the first, a single ranking will be drawn up, without any differentiation by school and course of study or year of course, defined in descending order of score calculated on the basis of the criteria established by art. 19 of the call (score from the scholarship ranking). In case of equal scores, the position in the ranking is determined with reference to the increasing value of ISEE. With the same ISEE, the position in the ranking is determined in increasing order of ISPE and, subsequently, increasing in age.

To express interest in the housing service, the following procedure must be performed:

1. **ACCESS** the internet application made available in the reserved area of the "ersuonline" services of the student portal, accessible from the link <https://studenti.ersumessina.it>, as indicated below:
 - a) adult students in possession of an identity document issued by the Italian authorities (eg. Identity card) and international students who declare residence in Italy, access the reserved area with SPID or CIE;
 - b) international students in possession exclusively of an identity document issued by the authorities of their country and not resident in Italy, access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register on first access);
 - c) underage students access the reserved area using the credentials issued by the institution (register on first access);
2. **FILL** in the mandatory fields of the form **by 2:00 pm on October 31, 2022**;
3. **CONFIRM** the data entered and wait for an SMS with an OTP code for their validation (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
4. **VALIDATE** the data entered in the benefit request by reporting the OTP code received via SMS in the appropriate field (only for those who log in with username and password credentials);
5. **FINISH** the procedure.

Technical assistance and answers to questions sent by e-mail will be guaranteed **until 1:00 pm on October 31, 2022**.

The ranking of new bed assignees who have expressed interest in accommodation will be published on the ERSU institutional website.

Acceptance of the bed must **be made by 2:00 pm on the fifth day from the date of publication of the aforementioned ranking**, under penalty of forfeiture of the benefit, in the same manner as provided for by art. 35.

The assignments will take into account the places left available, once the needs deriving from the rankings and the proximity of the residences themselves to the attended didactic centers have been satisfied.

The student who for various reasons does not respond to the ERSU communication of assignment of the accommodation place will be considered renouncing and may submit a

rental declaration, pursuant to Article 23, but not accessing the rent contribution. Once the validity of the documentation submitted has been verified, the student will be granted the status of an "off-site" student and will only benefit from the integration of the "commuter" to "off-site" scholarship and the second free full meal.

The non-renouncing student, who is not assigned to university residences due to unavailability of accommodation, will be able to access the rent contribution, in the manner and within the time limits provided for in Article 23.



Any further assignments will be communicated through a notice on the institutional website. No communication will be sent by email or by telephone. The communication through publication on the institutional website is valid for all purposes as notification.

Art. 38

Fee for the use of the bed

They do not pay the tuition:

- ✓ eligible scholarships and bed assignees;
- ✓ eligible scholarships and non-enrolled bed assignees for the academic year 2022/2023, as undergraduates, limited to the first semester;
- ✓ eligible scholarships and bed assignees enrolled in the 1st fc, to whom the housing service is extended for a further semester;
- ✓ students with disabilities.

They pay the fee:

- ✓ bed assignees who have not requested the scholarship;

As set out in table 4 of the call, after the verification of the credits obtained as of 30/11/2023, the first year students, eligible for a scholarship and the winners and assignees of a bed, who achieve only 20 ECTS by 30 / 11/2023 will have to pay the bed fee in the amount of 50% of what is foreseen.

The fees are defined in table 13 in the appendix and are commensurate with the period in which the ERSU will provide the housing services.

The payment of the deposit and the fee (if due), must be made, in the manner prescribed by law, through the PagoPa service, by connecting to the link <https://secure.pmpay.it/pmPortal/noregSearchSession.do?codCompany=PA821> of the institutional website of the organization.

Bed assignees are required to deliver, upon acceptance of the bed, the receipt of payment of the fee in the residence of assignment.

In the event that the delay in payment of the fee extends beyond 15 days from the terms of acceptance of the bed, the benefits attributed will be suspended.

In the event that the delay extends beyond 30 days, the benefits will be revoked.

Art. 39

Forfeiture of the housing service

The housing service recipients who are no longer entitled to any additional fee to the scholarship are no longer entitled to the housing service and, if they are recipients of a

scholarship, who:

- do not accept the bed and / or do not show up for the assignment of the bed within the times indicated by the institution;
- do not present an expression of interest in the bed;
- omit or present incomplete documentation required for acceptance of the bed;
- obtain a degree;
- formally renounce the bed;
- violate the current Regulations of the University Residences of the Body;
- move to another university;
- they are not up to date with the payment of the fee (see art. 38);
- have allowed third parties, for whatever reason, the improper use of their accommodation. In this case, the interested parties are also required to pay an amount equal to the daily "average cost" for the days of undue use;
- are absent for ten or more days from the accommodation without providing adequate justification to the Manager of the U.O.B. 2 "University residences and catering". In this case, they are also required to pay an amount equal to the daily "average effective cost" for the period in which they were unjustified absent. The presence, as well as being certified by the signature affixed every week in the appropriate registers, must be proven by the actual occupation of the assigned accommodation;
- enrolled in a first year of the course, have not obtained at least 15 credits on 10 august 2023 and at least 20 credits by 30 november 2023 (art. 6 paragraph 1 and 3 D.P.C.M. 09/04/2001) so as detailed in table 4. In this case, for the period of use for which they were not entitled to housing, they will have to reimburse € 125.00 for each month or an amount equal to the "effective average cost" per day for fraction of month;
- enrolled in a first year of a course, with disabilities or Specific Learning Disorders (SLD) have not earned at least 9 credits as of 10 august 2023 and at least 12 credits by 30 november 2023 (art. 6 paragraph 1 and 3 D.P.C.M. 09/04/2001) as detailed in table 4. In this case, for the period of use for which they were not entitled to housing, they will have to reimburse € 125.00 for each month or an amount equal to the daily "average cost" for fractions of a month;
- enrolled in years subsequent to the first, do not have the requisites required following the verification carried out by this ERSU. In this case, for the period of use for which they were not entitled to housing, they will have to reimburse € 125.00 for each month or an amount equal to the "effective average cost" per day for fraction of the month;
- enrolled in years subsequent to the first, with disabilities or Specific Learning Disorders (SLD), do not have the requisites required following the verification carried out by this ERSU. In this case, for the period of use for which they were not entitled to housing, they will have to reimburse € 125.00 for each month or an amount equal to the actual average cost "daily for fraction of the month";
- graduate and must therefore leave the room within five days of graduation. In any case, the graduation must be promptly communicated to the competent E.R.S.U. in order not to incur further sanctions;
- are in a suspended situation because they have not regularized their enrollment at the University. Therefore, in this case, they are required to leave the accommodation and for the period of use for which they were not entitled to housing, they will have to reimburse € 125.00 for each month or an amount equal to the "effective average cost" per day. fraction of a month.

The student, declared forfeited from the right to a bed for the aforementioned reasons, will have to pay the tuition as provided for in Article 13, relating to the period for which he benefited from the benefit.

Art. 40

Catering service

The canteens of this institution are distributed throughout the municipality of Messina near the university study centers, as follows:

- central canteen via Ghibellina, 146, - 98123 Messina, near the headquarters of the University of Messina - lunch hours from 12:00 to 14:30, all week; dinner hours from 19:00 to 20:30, all week; and in any case closed on the days of public holidays and on the days provided for in the next paragraph;
- Polyclinic canteen, viale Giovanni Battista Cortesi, inside the citadel of the "G. Martino " - via Consolare Valeria, 1 - 98125 Messina - lunch hours from 12:00 to 14:30, from Monday to Friday; closed dinner hours; and in any case closed on days before holidays and holidays and in those provided for in the next paragraph;
- Annunziata canteen, inside the UnimeSport Annunziata citadel via A. Giuffrè - 98168 Messina - lunch hours from 12:00 to 14:30, Monday to Friday; dinner hours from 19:00 to 20:30, from Monday to Thursday; and in any case closed on days before holidays and holidays and in those provided for in the next paragraph;
- Papardo canteen, inside the university citadel located in the Papardo district, viale Ferdinando Stagno D'Alcontres - 98158 Messina - lunch hours from 12:00 to 14:30, from Monday to Friday; dinner hours from 19:00 to 20:30, from Monday to Thursday; and in any case closed on days before holidays and holidays and in those provided for in the next paragraph.

All the times described above refer to the ticket office hours. Therefore, it is allowed to remain inside the canteens up to half an hour after closing time, to complete the consumption of meals.

The closing periods of all canteens roughly coincide with those of the housing service, also provided by this institution, according to the following distribution throughout the year:

- from 19 december 2022 to 06 january 2023 (closing for Christmas holidays)
- or from 24 july 2023 to 03 september 2023 (summer closure).

Any closing periods, identified for various reasons by this body, will be communicated through notices published on the bulletin board and on the website www.ersumessina.it

To use the restaurant service, you can access the university canteens only in the following ways:

- Students who did not participate in the competition for the assignment of the scholarship for the A.Y. in progress, they must submit a request for the catering service using a special procedure called "Catering service" available in the "Requests" section of the ERSU student portal <https://studenti.ersumessina.it>. To access the portal, it is necessary to have SPID or CIE credentials. Access is allowed with a tax code and password only for foreign students and minors, after registration.
- Students who participated in the competition for the assignment of the scholarship for the A.Y. in progress they will have to upload a passport-size photo in the E.R.S.U. student portal, if not previously uploaded.

To access the service, even if provided free of charge, and for identification purposes, students must use the "ERSUMESSINA" smartphone APP, which can be downloaded from the Apple and Google stores.

To download the APP, just scan the QR Code below and follow the instructions.



To use the APP, you must activate on the smartphone:

- internet connection;
- Bluetooth;
- geolocation.

Near the canteen, you must select the type of meal you want to eat from the main screen of the ERSUMESSINA APP and wait for confirmation (authorization granted).

If the necessary permissions have not been granted or have been revoked, access the smartphone settings and activate them as indicated above.

Students who access the paid restaurant service will have to top up their electronic purse, available on the personal page of the ERSU student portal in the "Recharge electronic purse" section or through a special section available in the APP, according to the amounts provided by the system. .

During the first access to the APP it is necessary to proceed with the association of the smartphone to the code

user tax, by pressing the "Associate device" button of the APP. In case of replacement of the smartphone, you will have to proceed with a new association. It is not possible to re-pair the phone before 30 days from the last association. Re-association within 30 days from the last will be possible only for justified reasons by going personally to the ERSU offices.

The catering service expires on November 30 of each year.

External parties will be able to access the catering service by paying the rate corresponding to the chosen menu directly at the cash desk.

In the event of a malfunction of the access management and / or meal reservation computer system, students will be admitted to the catering service at the rate provided for the first bracket.

The catering service is aimed at all students regularly enrolled for the A.Y. 2022/2023 at the University of Messina as well as at the "A. Corelli ", limited to students enrolled in courses for which possession of a secondary education diploma is required. For students there are 5 different income brackets with the relative amount to be paid upon access to the canteen (see the catering regulations available on the website of the Body www.ersumessina.it).

The catering service is totally free for all successful students of the housing service or assignees of the rent contribution, as detailed in table 9.

The catering service is free only once a day, for lunch or dinner, for all first-year winners and winners and eligible students of years subsequent to the first of the scholarship. The student who eats a full meal for lunch will have to pay the cost of the full meal at dinner according to the bracket, as specified in table 14.1 and precisely:

- for the first bracket with ISEE between € 0.00 and 1/3 of the limit (up to € 7,300.53), the cost of the complete meal is € 1.60;
- for the second bracket with ISEE between 1/3 of the limit and 2/3 of the limit (from € 7,300.54 up to € 14,601.07), the cost of the complete meal is € 2.10;
- for the third bracket with ISEE between 2/3 of the limit and the limit (from € 14,601.08 up to € 21,901.60) the cost of the complete meal is € 2.60.

The benefit of the use of the catering service is granted to:

- "off-site" students, as winners of the housing service or assignees of rent contributions, pursuant to art. 23 of this announcement. They will be entitled to two free meals, from the date of acceptance of the accommodation place or from the date of publication of the scholarship ranking, up to the date of publication of the scholarship ranking for the A.Y. 2023/2024. In this case, they are entitled to a total number of equivalent meals equal to 360 to be consumed within the academic year, as shown in table 14 in the appendix;
- students of the branch offices of the University of Messina to whom the rent contribution is recognized, according to the procedures set out in art. 23. In this case, in the absence of an agreement with local catering companies, the same will receive a supplement to the scholarship, equal to € 600.00 for on-site and commuter students and € 1,200.00 for off-site students ;
- students attending the Messina campus who are in particular situations to which the rent contribution is recognized, according to the procedures set out in art. 23. They will be entitled to two free meals, from the date of publication of the scholarship ranking, until the date of publication of the scholarship ranking for the A.Y. 2023/2024. In this case, they are entitled to a total number of equivalent meals equal to 360 to be consumed within the academic year, as shown in table 14 in the appendix;
- students who have won the A.Y. scholarship 2022/2023, off-site, from the publication of the rankings until the publication of the rankings of the scholarship of the A.Y. following. In this case, they are entitled to a total number of equivalent meals equal to 360 to be consumed within the academic year, as shown in table 14 in the appendix;
- on-site and commuter students, eligible and recipients of scholarships, enrolled in the years following the first and for first-year students, on-site and commuters, recipients of scholarships, a free daily meal from the publication of the rankings until publication of the rankings of the scholarship of the A.Y. following. In this case, they are entitled to a total number of equivalent meals equal to 360 to be consumed within the academic year, as shown in the table in the appendix to the announcement.
- students eligible for a scholarship in the first year, the catering service is provided at the rate corresponding to the first bracket, equal to € 1.60.
- students who do not fall within the categories referred to in the previous paragraphs of this article, the provisions of the "Regulations of the catering service" apply.

Users who reach the maximum meal limit, provided for in the previous paragraphs, will be able to take advantage of the full-price catering service.

First-year students who are eligible in the scholarship rankings will be assigned the subsidized bracket according to the provisions of the catering regulations.

Students who have applied for benefits and who are in possession of their matriculation number, **or demonstrate that they are enrolled for the A.Y. 2022/2023**, pending the publication of the provisional lists, will be able to obtain the activation of the catering service. They will be assigned the range relating to the declared ISEE, as provided for in the catering regulations.

Scholarship recipients enrolled in the educational centers of Noto, Priolo and Reggio Calabria will be able to enjoy meals at a partner restaurant. Alternatively, the amount of the scholarship will be increased by € 600.00 for "on-site" and "commuter" students and by € 1,200.00 for "off-site" students.

For anything not expressly reported, please refer to the provisions of the current Regulation of the catering service published in the appropriate section of the "Transparent Administration" portal of the institutional website.

3.5% of the allocated economic resources will be reserved for the following categories:

- 52%, up to a maximum of 54, scholarships reserved for international students from non-EU countries, as per table 8 in the appendix, or for international students who are political refugees, entitled to international protection;
- 14.36%, up to a maximum of 15, scholarships reserved for orphaned students of victims of work;
- 2.89%, up to a maximum of 3, grants reserved for international students who are children of Sicilian emigrants abroad;
- 1.93%, up to a maximum of 2, scholarships reserved for students orphans of victims for mafia reasons;
- 4.82%, up to a maximum of 5, scholarships reserved for students who are victims of usury and / or students who are children of victims of usury;
- 14.36%, up to a maximum of 15, grants reserved for students residing for at least 5 years in the smaller islands falling within the territory of the Sicilian Region;
- 9.64%, up to a maximum of 10, grants reserved for orphaned students who can prove that they have been guests in a public or private reception facility.

N.B. The scholarship will be granted to all students with disabilities, as per art. 3 paragraphs 1 and 3 of Law 104/92, and / or with a disability of not less than 66%, referred to in art. 14 of the Prime Ministerial Decree of April 9, 2001, in possession of the requisites provided for in the announcement.

Up to a maximum of 4.0% of the allocated economic resources will be reserved for contributions for international mobility. The "Integration for graduates" contribution (degree award) will be disbursed after the scholarship rankings have been exhausted.

Table 3 - GUIDELINES for the correct determination of merit

- In calculating the required credits, all those acquired must be considered, even deriving from tests passed with judgment or suitability, provided that the tests are recorded on the study plan by the Student Secretariat with a date not later than 10 August 2022;
 - For degree courses, whose didactic organization includes modules and / or integrated courses, only credits from closed modules and / or complete integrated courses must be taken into consideration, which must in any case be registered in the study plan by the Student Secretariats by on 10 August 2022;
 - Internships and training activities will be considered valid only if registered on the study plan with a date not later than 10 August 2022;
 - Credits are valid only if recognized for the course of study for which the student is requesting benefits, therefore those who have passed the degree course cannot include credits from non-validated tests in the calculation of merit;
 - For the purpose of obtaining the merit necessary to maintain or access the benefits, any credits validated or dispensed by the university institution relating to previous university or pre-academic career, nor those deriving from renounced or lapsed careers will not be taken into consideration;
 - Credits from subjects taken in single courses and / or extra-curricular activities, whose credits are not recognized for the attainment of the degree of the course in which the student is enrolled, will not be taken into consideration, even if validated and uploaded to the study plan. Education;
 - Credits earned abroad as part of international mobility programs are considered valid only if sustained by 10 August 2022, even if validated by the secretariat with a later date.
 - The subjects chosen can be indicated independently by the student, as long as they are consistent with the training project and recognized in the study plan. Therefore, they can be included in the credit count for the purpose of the scholarship.

Table 7 - Definition of the family unit

The family unit is defined pursuant to the D.P.C.M. 5/12/2013, n. 159, art. 3 and the INPS Circular 18/12/2014 n. 171.

The student's family unit is made up of the student requesting the benefits and all those who are included in the personal family status at the date of submission of the application, even if not related by family ties, as well as components dependent on IRPEF even if not living with the family of origin.

Therefore, the student who resides with students who are not part of the conventional family unit (e.g. grandparents, uncles, and / or other), but is the tax burden of the parents, must integrate, for ISEE purposes, also the family status parents and declare the income produced by their parents (ISEE attracted).

In the event of separation or divorce, the family unit of the student requesting the benefits is integrated with that of the parent who receives the student's maintenance allowances. In the event that the parents belong to two different families, in the absence of separation or divorce, the student's family unit is integrated with those of both parents.

For PhD and specialization courses, the applicant for benefits has the right to declare a "small" family unit consisting of himself, his spouse and children, if any (DPCM no. 159/2013).

The self-employed student, whose family unit does not take into account the members of the family of origin, is recognized if in possession of both of the following requirements:

- a) residence outside the housing unit of the family of origin, for at least two years from the date of submission of the application, in accommodation not owned by one of its members;
- b) income from employment or similar fiscally declared, for at least two years, usually not less than € 9.000,00 with reference to a family of one person.

In the absence of even one of the aforementioned requirements, the student must also indicate the income received by members of the family of origin in the ISEE certificate.

Students who are married and / or have children and do not have the conditions to be considered an "independent student" (limited to point b, income from employment or similar fiscally declared, for at least two years, usually not less than € 9.000,00 also if produced by the spouse), for the purposes of accessing benefits for the right to university study, it must in any case be "attracted" to the family unit of origin without any spouse and / or children.

The **international student** is required to submit the calculation of the equalized ISEEU / ISPEU (contact the CAF for the determination). Based on the country in which the income is produced and the assets of the family of origin are available, it is also necessary to attach the documentation issued by the competent authorities of the country, translated into Italian and legalized, to the scholarship application, if expected. The international student is always obliged to declare the income and assets possibly owned in Italy by their family unit.

The international student residing in Italy, without income and assets abroad, being equivalent to Italian students, must be in possession of the ISEE certificate for benefits for the right to university study.

If the interested parties, despite having requested the calculation of the equalized ISEEU / ISPEU, are not in possession of it at the time of completing the application, they can attach the aforementioned documentation to the scholarship application. The Institution will automatically

calculate the indicators of the economic and financial situation for the benefits for the right to education.



For the purposes of the correct determination of the family unit, please refer to the provisions of current legislation.

Informative note

The total amount of the scholarship (hereinafter BS), defined by the D.P.C.M. April 9, 2001 and recalled by the D.M. 1320/2021, is given by the sum of the monetary portion relating to the actual scholarship (hereinafter bs), the monetary portion relating to the housing service (hereinafter sa) and the monetary portion relating to the catering service (hereinafter sr) :

The total amount of the BASE scholarship, paid to students whose economic condition is less than or equal to 2/3 of the fixed ISEE limit, is determined as follows:

- **€ 2,481.75 per "on-site" student;**
- **€ 3,598.51 per commuter student;**
- **€ 6,157.74 per "off-site" student and per "independent" student.**

For an ISEE value higher than 2/3 and up to the fixed ISEE limit, the total amount of the BASE scholarship is gradually reduced up to 50%; for an ISEE value below 50% of the fixed ISEE limit, the total amount of the BASE scholarship is increased by 15%.

The total amount of the scholarship is reduced by the monetary amount relating to the catering service in the event that students enjoy one / two meals a day free of charge at the institution's catering outlets.

The total amount of the scholarship for "off-site" students is reduced by the monetary amount relating to the housing service in the event that they take advantage of a free bed in a R.U. of the Entity.

The total amount of the scholarship is reduced by the monetary portion relating to the catering service, in the event that students enjoy one / two daily meals free of charge at the institution's catering points, and by the monetary portion relating to the housing service, in the event that they take advantage of the free bed at a R.U. of the Entity.

The amount of the scholarship to be paid (bs), therefore, is given by the total amount of the scholarship (BS) net of the deductions of any sums corresponding to the value of the services used for free (housing service and catering service):

$$bs = BS - sa - sr$$

How can you read the tables below? How is the amount of the scholarship to be awarded determined?

From the total amount of the BASE scholarship (possibly increased by 15% or gradually reduced up to 50% depending on the ISEE), the Entity withholds any sums corresponding to the value of the services used for free (housing service and catering service) .

Therefore, from the total amount of the scholarship (BS):

- **the monetary portion relating to the housing service (sa) is subtracted** from those who benefit from a free bed in a R.U. of the Entity,
- **the monetary portion relating to the catering service (sr) is subtracted** from those who enjoy one or two daily meals free of charge at the institution's active catering points;
- **the monetary portion relating to the housing service (sa) and the monetary**

portion relating to the catering service (sr) are subtracted from those who enjoy free of charge both the bed at a R.U. of the Entity and of daily meals at the Entity's active catering outlets.

The beds, a total of n. 290 **for the Messina campus**, intended for students with a degree course in Messina, will be divided as follows:

- ✓ n° 77 at the Papardo residence;
- ✓ n° 83 at the Annunziata residence;
- ✓ N°130 places at the Residenza Gravitelli.

The subdivision referred to in the previous paragraph is not binding for the ERSU as it is subject to the actual availability of seats.

The distribution of the 290 accommodation places will take place as follows:

- 15 reserved accommodation places, up to a maximum of 5% of the available places, divided as follows:

- 5 places for disabled students at the Gravitelli residence;
- 2 places for disabled students at the Papardo residence;
- 1 place for disabled students at the Annunziata residence;
- 3 places for students residing for at least five years in the smaller islands of Sicily;
- 2 places for international students from particularly poor non-EU countries, as per Ministerial Decree no. 358 of 3.5.2018, or to political refugees entitled to international protection;
- 2 places for students who are orphans or without parental responsibility as a result of a court order, who demonstrate that they are guests or have been guests in public or private reception facilities.

- n ° 275 accommodation places, divided as follows:

- 1/5 to students enrolled for the first time in three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses;
- 4/5 for students enrolled in the second and subsequent years of the three-year degree, single-cycle master's degree, two-year master's degree, specialization and research doctorate courses.

If it is not possible to assign the beds according to the above subdivision due to the limitations deriving from the social distancing resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, we will communicate the beds actually available at the time of publication of the lists of scholarship participants on **21 september 2022**.

In relation to the self-declared data in the DSU, the Revenue Agency carries out specific checks also to verify whether there is correspondence between what is indicated by users in the section relating to movable assets and the information present in the registry of relationships (Article 11, paragraph 3 , DPCM n.159 / 2013).

If from these checks there are omissions or discrepancies between the self-declared data and the information present in the registry of reports, the Agency makes these anomalies available to INPS, highlighting in the annotations of the ISEE attestation the specifications of the omissions / discrepancies, the date on which the check took place, the DSU protocol and the tax codes of the members of the nucleus to which the anomaly found refers. With particular reference to movable assets, if one of the members of the nucleus, in compiling the DSU, has omitted or incorrectly exposed one or more financial reports, the aforementioned notes will contain the complete list of all financial relationships referring to that component.

In cases of omissions or discrepancies, according to the legislation in force (paragraph 5 of the aforementioned article 11), the applicant for any service has two possible alternatives:

- 1) submit a new DSU, including information previously omitted or otherwise disclosed.
- 2) submit an application for the service of your interest using the same ISEE certificate bearing the annotation of omissions or discrepancies and attaching appropriate documentation to prove the completeness and truthfulness of the data indicated in the declaration. The documentation must be requested exclusively by the user from the intermediary (Bank, Italian Post Office, etc.) who communicated the financial reports to the Revenue Agency.



From the date of the publication of the lists and by the end of the corrections / additions period, the applicant must take action to resolve the provisional rejection of the application in one of the two aforementioned possibilities.

The section of online services of the ERSU of Messina, called "ersuonline", can be reached by registering on the Student Portal.

Access to the benefits provided by the institution (scholarships, other contributions and services for the right to university study), is subject to the inclusion of personal data.

1. Object of the treatment
